



Taste of the Fair Drive-Thru FAQs

1. Which gate do I enter for the Taste of the Fair?

-Participants will enter the Main Parking Lot at Gate 3, on Al Bishop Drive.

2. Do I have to stay in my car to order, or can I walk up to the food booths?

-Patrons have the choice to do "In-Car" or "Walk-Up" Service

3. What is the difference between "In-Car" and "Walk-Up" Service?

-**"In-Car" Service:** The "In-Car" Service will provide a limited menu. Participants will drive through the one way Taste of the Fair route to view the menus of each vendor. They will then park in the designated "In-Car Service" lot, where they will remain in their car, place their order with an attendant, and have it delivered to them.

-**"Walk-Up" Service:** Full vendor menu will be available. Participants will have the choice to drive through the one way Taste of the Fair route, view the menus of each vendor, park in the designated "Walk-Up Service" lot and walk to the food booths to place orders; or, to avoid lines, they can park across the street in the North Lot and walk across to the event.

4. What if I only want food from one specific vendor? Do I still have to wait in line?

-Each car will follow the same Taste of the Fair one way route, unless they choose to park in the North Lot and walk across to the event.

5. What if I want to purchase multiple items from multiple vendors?

-After completing the one way route, you will park your car and an attendant will take your complete order, or you may walk up and order from vendors individually.

6. When will menus be available?

-Menus are posted on our website and all social media platforms, or via this QR Code:

7. Is there an admission fee?

-Admission is free for this event. However, in recognition of the devastating impact the pandemic has had on one of our Fair partners, MUST Ministries, we are accepting donations of 7 non-perishable can goods. **Each individual that donates 7 cans will receive a FREE ticket to the 2021 Superior Plumbing presents North Georgia State Fair.**

8. Is there a parking fee?

-Parking is free for this event.

9. Can I order ahead?

-The option to order ahead is not available. You may either park and order from an attendant, or park and walk up.

10. Will seating and/or restrooms be available?

-Minimal seating will be available within the pedestrian area and in accordance with social distancing guidelines. You may also choose to eat in your car, or take it home. Minimal restroom facilities will also be available.

11. How will vehicles be routed through the vendors?

-Vehicles will follow a one-way route past all vendors and then choose "Walk-Up" or In-Car" Service, and then proceed to the appropriate parking area.

12. What payment types will vendors be accepting?

-Refer to each individual vendor for acceptable forms of payment.

13. Will ATMs be available?

- ATMs will be onsite.

14. When can I get in line for the Taste of the Fair drive through event?

-Taste of the Fair opens Friday at 4pm, and 12pm Saturday and Sunday. Gates will open 30 minutes prior to scheduled opening.

15. Do I have to wear a mask?

-We are adhering to all social distancing guidelines. Those who choose to order and eat in their cars are not required to wear a mask. Individuals who choose walk up service are strongly encouraged to wear masks.

16. Do prices include tax?

-All menu prices include tax.

17. Can I ride my bicycle through the Taste of the Fair?

-All participants in the drive through food route must be in a motorized vehicle.

18. How does the Taste of the Fair drive through process work?

-Vehicles will enter Gate 3 of the Main Parking Lot on Al Bishop Dr., proceed through a one-way route, choose "In-Car" or "Walk-Up" service and park in the appropriate area.**This is NOT your typical "fast food" drive through experience. Please plan accordingly and be prepared to spend a little time with us so you can fully enjoy your fair food event.

19. How can I help MUST Ministries?

-By donating seven non-perishable canned goods each person will receive a free ticket to the 2021 Superior Plumbing North Georgia State Fair. Look for MUST Ministries two booths – one located next to the pedestrian walk through gate and the other near drive through exit.
