The proposed draft Consolidated Plan, 2021 recommended allocations, 2021 Annual Action Plan will be included on the **Tuesday, November 10, 2020** Board of Commissioners' Agenda.

A **10-day** public comment period commences on **Thursday, October 8, 2020** and will conclude on **Thursday, October 22, 2020**.
