



# Cobb Superior Court Keeping Grand Jurors Safe

*Your Safety is our Priority*

The Cobb County Superior Court Judges along with the Cobb County District Attorney's office would like to thank you in advance for your Grand Jury service. We want you to know the Cobb Judicial Circuit has your health and safety in mind when you report for your upcoming Grand Jury service. As we transition from this public health crisis, Cobb County and this court has taken the necessary precautions to ensure that our court is sanitized and cleaned for your safety. The entire court including the jury assembly room, courtrooms and jury rooms have been modified to meet the CDC's guidelines for social distancing.

You are required to confirm your Grand Jury attendance through our website [cobbcounty.org/superiorcourtjury](http://cobbcounty.org/superiorcourtjury), next click "Grand Juror information" located on the menu bar, and once you are on the Grand Jury site, please confirm your attendance through the link: Confirm Grand Jury Attendance & Qualifications. You can also access our website through the QR Code. If you cannot confirm your attendance through our website, please contact our office at 770-528-1757 option 0. This confirmation is very important, as it allows the Superior Court to keep a precise count of jurors appearing at the courthouse



Once your Grand Jury service attendance is confirmed, Jurors will receive a confirmation email detailing all the instructions for the Grand Jury selection process.

This video can answer many questions about the Grand Jury process. Additionally, our website provides other helpful information about your Grand Jury service.

**TERM OF SERVICE:** The Grand Jury consists of twenty-three (23) members and three (3) alternates. Grand Jurors serve for a two-month term. *If you are selected* to serve on the Grand Jury, you will meet on average one to two days per week. **JUROR FEES:** Grand Jurors are paid \$25.00 per day for the days you physically appear. You will receive a check and certificate of attendance from Superior Court Jury Administration for the days you attend.

**PERSONS INELIGIBLE FOR SERVICE ON A GRAND JURY:** Elected officials in state and local government or those who have held office within two years preceding service as a Grand Juror. Nonresidents of Cobb County, Non-US Citizens, under 18 years of age, if you are a convicted felon and your rights have not been restored. You cannot serve on a Grand Jury if you are presently in any pretrial release program, pretrial diversion program, mental health court program, veterans court diversion program, or any similar pretrial diversion program from this state, any other state, or from any federal court programs for any felony offense, YOU MUST SUBMIT PROOF TO JURY ADMINISTRATION either U.S. Mail, email: [superiorcourtjury@cobbcounty.org](mailto:superiorcourtjury@cobbcounty.org) ; or fax: 770-528-1808. SUBMITTING THIS IN A TIMELY MANNER IS IMPERATIVE.
