Vendor Registration

- Visit our external website:
 <u>www.cobbcounty.org/purchasing</u>
- Click on Vendor Registration to register with our Vendor Self Service (VSS) system
- Click on Bidding Opportunities to view our current solicitations then click on any individual bid link to be directed to our e-Procurement site (BidNet Direct)

Procurement Thresholds

- < \$2,000 Departmental Purchase Orders (PDs)</p>
- **\$2,000 to \$49,999.99** requires a minimum of three quotes
- \$50,000.00 or Greater –formal solicitation: Invitation to Bid (ITB) or Request for Proposals (RFP)

Formal Solicitation Methods

- ► Invitation to Bid (ITB) Award made to lowest responsive and responsible bidder ("low bid")
- Request for Proposals (RFP) Award usually made to highest ranked firm based on qualitative factors in addition to cost (each factor assigned points)

Master Agreements

- ► Master Agreements —term contract of generally one (1) year with option for two (2) additional one (1) year terms
- Commonly used goods or services ordered from contract on an as needed basis – generally priced per unit cost
- Procured by Sealed Bid or Written Quotations depending on the anticipated annual dollar volume

Local Vendor Presence

- Applies to Request for Proposals for professional services
- Awarded as bonus points
 - Contracts between \$50,000 \$100,000 (5 bonus points)
 - Contracts in excess of \$100,000 (3 bonus points)

E-Verify

- Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act
- Physical Performance of Services any performance of labor or services for a public employer using a bidding process or by contract wherein the labor or services exceed \$2,499.99.

Tips for Successful Vendors

Searching for opportunities

- Monitor bid advertisements regularly (websites, MDJ)
- Maintain contact with departments and buyers
- Keep your vendor information updated (both in VSS and BidNet Direct)

Responding to solicitations:

- Pay attention to deadlines and details
- Ask questions
- Proofread your submission


