





16th Annual Tappy Turtle Artist Challenge

Contest:

Cobb County Water System and Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority invite local 4th and 5th graders to draw their best picture of Cobb Water's friendly mascot, Tappy Turtle, practicing a water conservation habit! A panel of judges will choose a minimum of 12 winning drawings that will be published in the 2021 Adventures with Tappy Turtle Coloring Book!

The book will be unveiled, and winning students will be honored at a virtual Artist Party the evening of **February 4**. The educational coloring book will be distributed throughout the community to educate others about water conservation.

To Enter:

- On the back of this form, **using black ink**, draw a creative picture of Tappy Turtle practicing your school's specific water conservation habit. **Remember: don't fill in the outline of the drawing. Make sure it's large enough that a friend could color it in!**
- Entries are judged on creativity, the water conservation tip illustrated, and artistic ability.
- Hand in the completed drawing to your teacher.

- When submitting entries, please include a school point of contact for the waterSmart Tappy Turtle Artist Challenge. This can be a teacher, administrator, school counselor, ASP director, etc. Please include a contact name and email address.
- Entries are due by **Friday**, **December 4th**, **by 3:30 p.m.**

Rules:

- Must be either a 4th or 5th grade student in a Cobb County or City of Marietta school.
- All drawings must depict your school's specific water conservation habit.
- Limit one entry per student, one student per entry.
