## waterSmart waterArt Call for Entries for 2021 Adventures with Tappy Turtle Coloring Book Contest

**MARIETTA, Ga. (November 15, 2020)** – The Cobb County Water System (CCWS) and the Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority (CCMWA) announce the opening of the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual waterSmart waterArt Adventures with Tappy Turtle coloring book contest.

This contest invites 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in Cobb County and City of Marietta School Districts to draw Cobb Water's Mascot, Tappy Turtle, practicing a water saving habit. Deadline for submissions is Friday, December 4, 2020, at 3:30pm, with a winner's virtual reception held February 4, 2021. Winning entries are compiled into a coloring book and distributed throughout the county.

The waterSmart program was initiated by the CCMWA in 2000, to educate its service area residents of all ages about the importance of indoor and outdoor water conservation, and to help encourage sustainable, year-round conservation, regardless of climate conditions.
