



COVID-19 Status Update


Total Positive Case Rate (244/100K) in Cobb County is still decreasing



Positivity Rate is the number of positive tests compared to total tests completed – Cobb is 5.5%

Interpreting COVID-19 community transmission data

Transmission levels are grouped as follows:

- High: greater than 100 cases per 100,000 county residents
- Moderately High: 51-100 cases per 100,000 county residents
- Moderate: 11-50 cases per 100,000 county residents
- Low: 0-10 cases per 100,000 county residents
- Cobb County community transmission remains HIGH (i.e., 244/100K residents; 5.5 percent positive tests)
- In the past several weeks, we have seen steady decreases in case rates, percent positive tests, emergency room visits, and hospitalizations -Fantastic trends!
- However, use caution over the last few days, we are seeing a plateau in the downward trends

Impact of viral variants on COVID-19 vaccine effectiveness

- B.1.1.7 ("UK variant")
- B.1.351 ("South African variant")
- P.1 ("Brazilian variant")
- These variants spread more easily and quickly than other variants
- UK variant may be associated with increased risk of death, but more studies needed
- Antibodies produced after receiving one of the currently authorized vaccines appear to recognize these variants, but more studies underway

COVID–19 Testing in Cobb County

- ➤ Still offering over 8,500 test options per week at Jim Miller Park plus satellite locations; will be transitioning some sites to satellite vaccination/testing sites
 - KSU BrandSmart North Cobb
 - EpiCenter/Word of Faith South Cobb
 - Eastwood Baptist Marietta/East Cobb
 - Legion Field Austell
 - North Metro Church West Cobb
 - Additional pop-up sites across district with Air National Guard
- Launched MAKO Testing at JMP in February (added 2,500 tests/wk)
- Still 24-48 hour turnaround on results with all sites above

Vaccination Sites – Cobb

CDPH has administered over 44,205 vaccinations to date

We have been working to particularly serve Cobb residents the past 10 weeks when eligibility expanded to seniors and schools

We have opened up new appointments weekly over the past 4 weeks to the capacity we have vaccine – getting about 40-50% of our order/capacity at this time.



Benefits of COVID-19 vaccination

- Effective at preventing symptomatic COVID-19
- May prevent serious illness in those who do get COVID-19
- May protect others from COVID-19
- Visit with other fully vaccinated people indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
- Visit with unvaccinated people from a single household who are at low risk for severe COVID-19 disease indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
- Refrain from quarantine and testing following a known exposure if asymptomatic

GA DPH Vaccine Eligibility (as of 3/24/21)

 All person 16 and order are now eligible!




