### Rental Assistance: Star-C

#### Help with apartment rent

- Star-C maybe able to cover up to 70% of your rent or up to \$4,850.
- Tenant pays 20%, Landlord pays 10%.
- You and your landlord must apply for the program.
- Properties must qualify.

#### Move out of Extended Stay

- Star-C maybe able to pay up to \$3,000 in deposit and first month's rent.
- Must get approval from an apartment on your own.
- Email or fax approval to Star-C.
- Landlord must submit w-9 form.

## Mortgage and Rental Payment Assistance

- Apply for **mortgage payment assistance** up to \$4,800 and/or homeownership counseling.
- You must have occupied the home prior to March 1, 2020 and be delinquent on your mortgage payment.
- Only for Cobb County homeowners.
- Online application required.
- First-come, first-serve basis.
- **Rental assistance** up to \$4,800.
- All applicants must meet eligibility criteria.
- Participate via a signed agreement.
- Landlord to provide the tenant's rental history.
- Forbear eviction proceedings (if applicable).
- Dismiss any pending dispossession case against the assisted tenant for the period covered by the grant (if applicable).
- Landlord must waive any late fees incurred associated with the delinquent rent period covered by the grant
- Online application required.

## Senior Assistance

\* Not funded by CARES Act.

- If you are 55 years or older, you may be eligible for limited financial assistance.
- Must provide a valid GA ID and Social Security card for all adults 18 years or older living in the household.
- Household income must be below 200% of federal poverty guidelines and lack sufficient resources to maintain permanent housing.
- Applications are done by appointment only. Call Cobb Senior Services at 770-5285364 to schedule.
- No walk-ins accepted.
- Not funded through CARES Act.
