



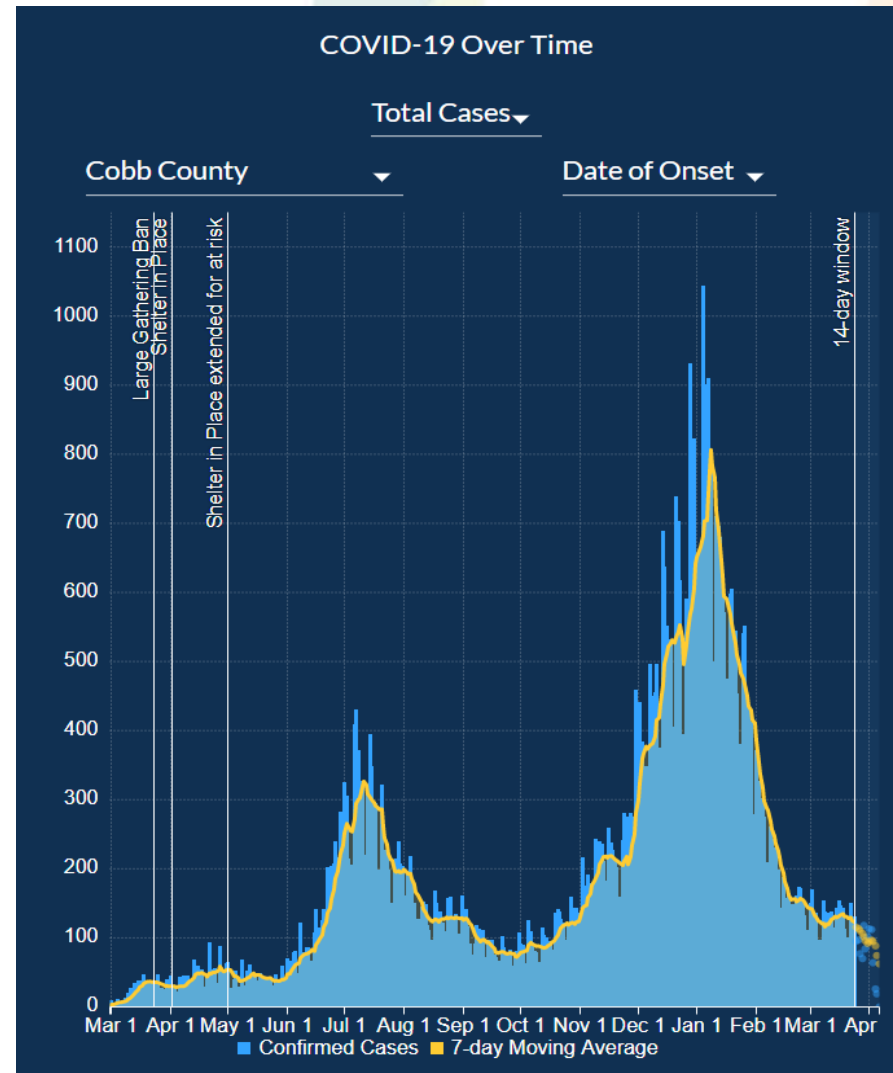
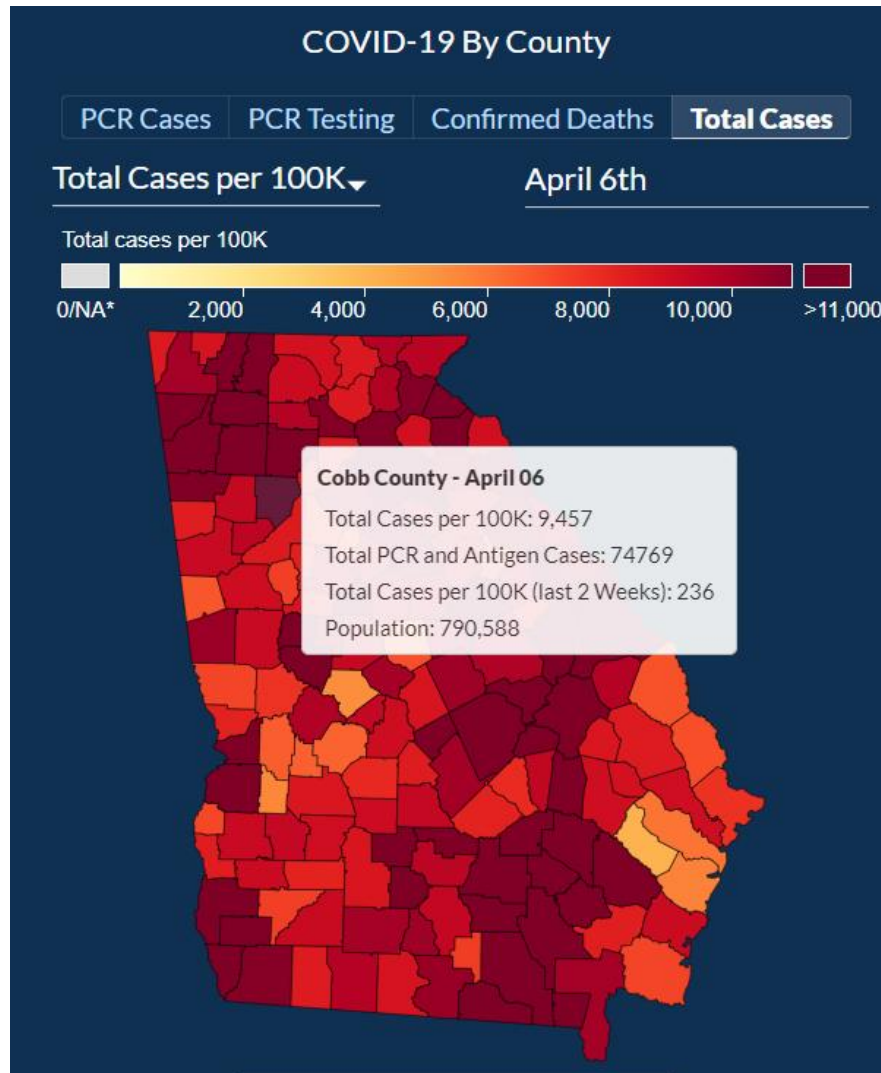

Positivity Rate is the number of positive tests compared to total tests completed – Cobb is 5.3% - still plateaued

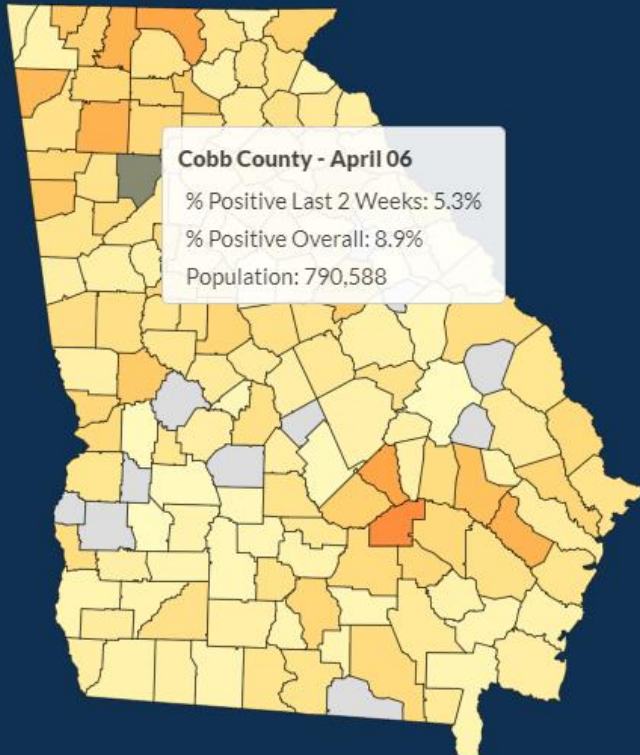

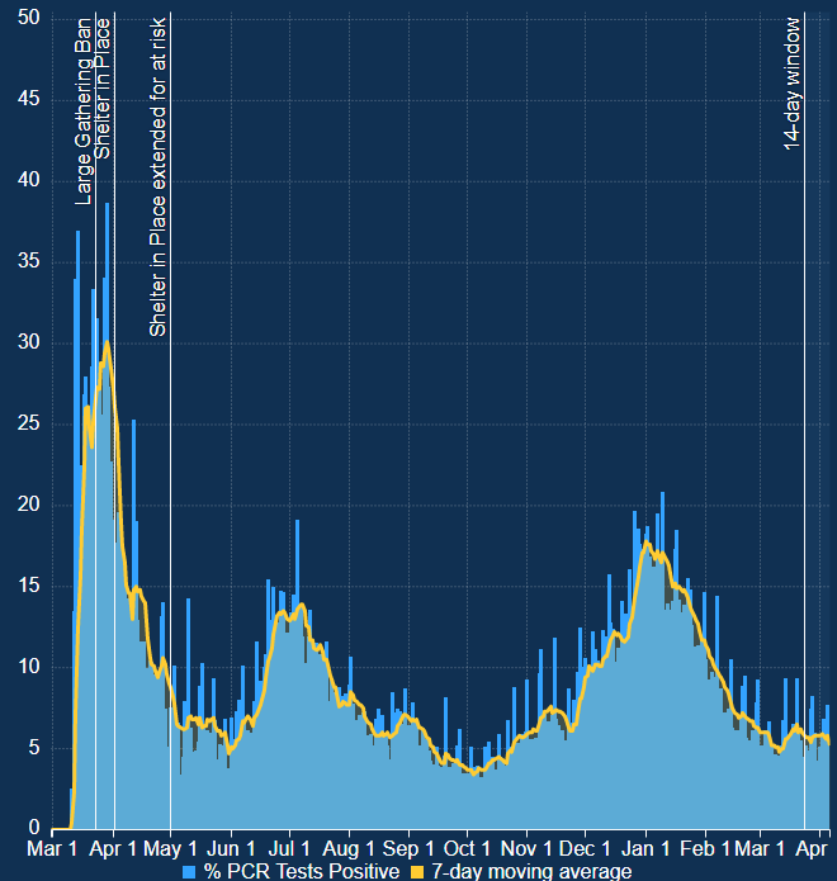

PCR Percent Positive▼

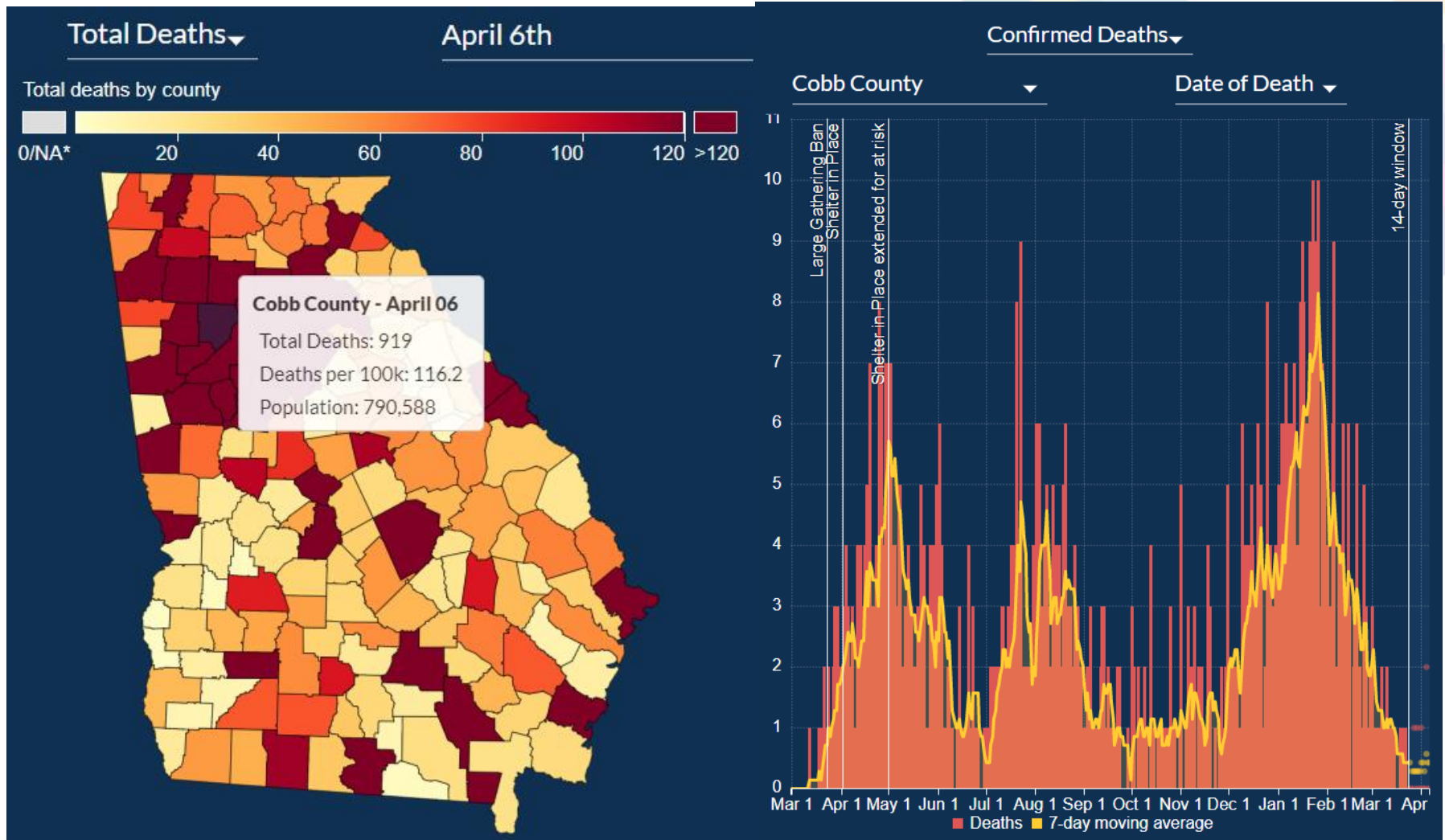

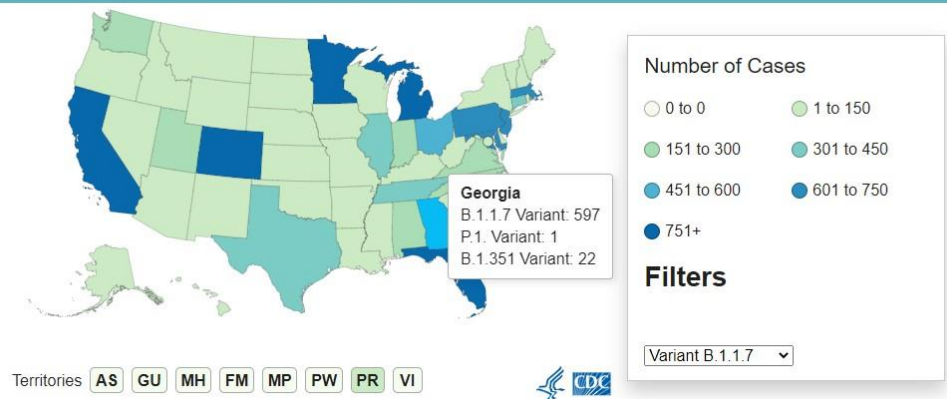

Impact of viral variants on COVID-19 vaccine effectiveness

- B.1.1.7 (“UK variant”)
- B.1.351 (“South African variant”)
- P.1 (“Brazilian variant”)
- These variants spread more easily and quickly than other variants; remember that only a small percentage of positive tests get processed for variants.
- UK variant may be associated with increased risk of death, but more studies needed
- Antibodies produced after receiving one of the currently authorized vaccines appear to recognize these variants, but more studies underway

COVID–19 Testing in Cobb County

Converted most testing sites to vaccination sites (250-500/day) on 3/31/21 in addition to JMP mass vaccination site (6 days/wk)

- MAKO Labs - PCR Testing at JMP (M-F)
 - KSU BrandSmart – North Cobb (CORE Vaccination/PCR Testing TU/TH)
 - St. Thomas Catholic Church – Smyrna (CORE Vaccination/PCR Testing FR)
 - Eastwood Baptist – Marietta/East Cobb (Air National Guard (ANG) PCR Testing WED)
 - Mosaic Community Center – Smyrna (ANG PCR Testing FR)
 - Legion Field –Austell Sat April 10

- Still need to register in advance
 - Still 24-48 hour turnaround on test results with all sites above

Benefits of COVID-19 vaccination

- Effective at preventing symptomatic COVID-19
- May prevent serious illness in those who do get COVID-19
- May protect others from COVID-19
- Visit with other fully vaccinated people indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
- Visit with unvaccinated people from a single household who are at low risk for severe COVID-19 disease indoors without wearing masks or physical distancing
- Refrain from quarantine and testing following a known exposure if asymptomatic

GA DPH Vaccine Eligibility (as of TH 3/25/21)

All Georgia residents
over 16 years of age are eligible
to get vaccinated

- * Note: only Pfizer Vaccine can be given to 16 & 17 year olds

If you are in Phase 1A+, please click on one of the links below to schedule an appointment to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

Beginning March 15, in addition to educators and staff, adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their caregivers, and parents of children with complex medical conditions, healthcare workers, first responders, and Georgians 65 years or older, Phase 1A+ will include Georgians who are 55 and older and Georgians who have serious health conditions will be eligible to receive their vaccines. These are the health conditions provided by the governor's office:

- Asthma (moderate to severe)
- Cancer
- Cerebrovascular Disease
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Cystic Fibrosis
- Diabetes
- Hypertension
- Heart conditions
- Immunocompromised state
- Liver disease
- Neurologic conditions (Dementia, ALS, Parkinson's)
- Overweight and obesity (BMI > 25 kg)
- Pulmonary Fibrosis
- Sickle Cell Disease
- Thalassemia

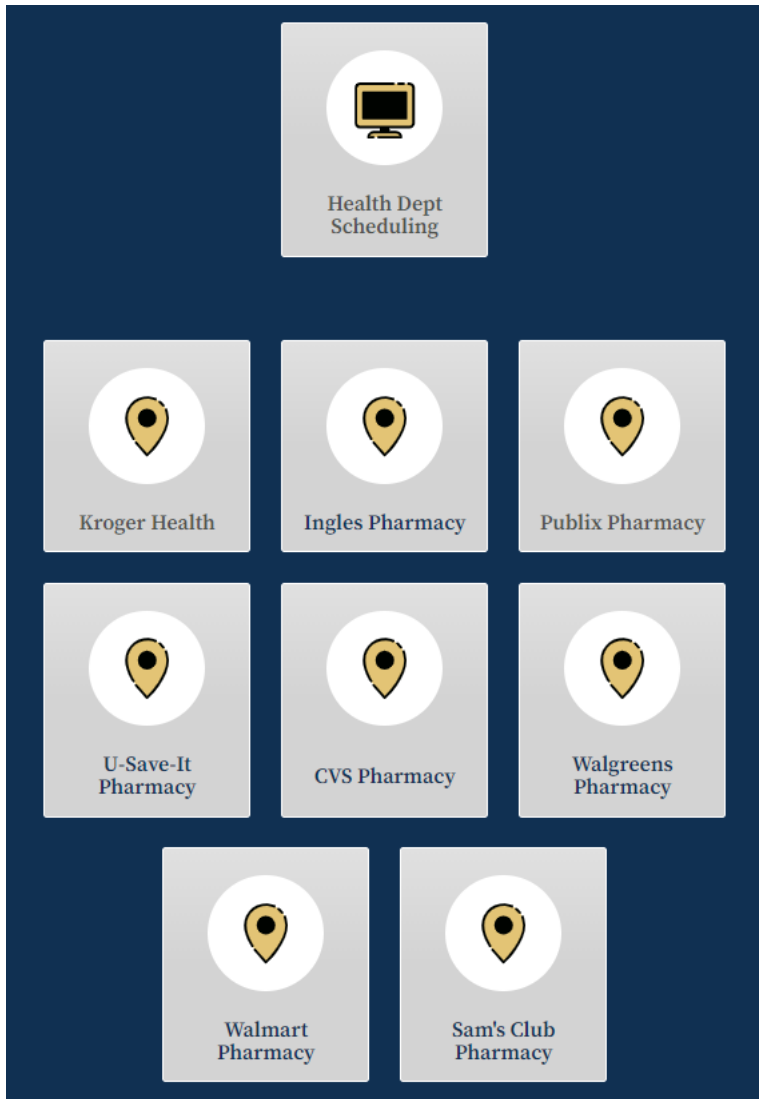
