You and your PCA may ride the local fixed-route bus for free with your Paratransit ID.



WAYS TO PAY

There are three ways to pay your fare:

- Use exact change at the fare box on board.
- Load money on your Paratransit Breeze Card (up to \$100) online, in-person or by phone.
- Purchase CobbLinc fare products, which are passes for a specific number of rides or time frame, online, in person or by phone.



Supporting Your Independence

Paratransit service runs seven days a week within a 3/4-mile area surrounding the existing local bus routes. The service hours and holiday schedule are comparable to the CobbLinc fixed-route system.

A CURB-TO-CURB, SHARED RIDE SERVICE

WHAT IS PARATRANSIT SERVICE?

Paratransit service is an ADA, shared-ride service for individuals with intellectual and physical disabilities. The service is required under the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA), which guarantees that people with disabilities have equal access to employment, public services and accommodations, transportation and telecommunications services.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

People with disabilities who live within the service area and are unable to access the local fixed-route bus are encouraged to apply. Eligibility is based on the analysis of the applicant's functional ability, not his or her medical condition alone. A disability that makes travel more difficult but not impossible, does not qualify as eligible.


CobbLinc will review your application and send a second application (Part B) to the professional you listed on yours.

MAKE A RESERVATION

You will then be able to make your reservation up to three days in advance by calling (770) 427-2222 or TDD 7-1-1. Same-day trips cannot be scheduled. Reservationists are available 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., seven days a week. If you need a MARTA Mobility transfer, let the reservationist know, and he or she will coordinate it for you.

If you live outside of the Paratransit service area, there is another program for which you may qualify. It provides vouchers for private transportation services, and participants only pay 10 percent of the cost. To qualify you are required to:

- Be a resident of Cobb County.
- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Complete the Paratransit application.
