

CALL FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION REFERENDUM FOR THE CITY OF VININGS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **TUESDAY, May 24, 2022**, in conjunction with the General Primary, a Special Election will be held in certain election districts in Cobb County to present a question to the qualified voters for their determination of whether to incorporate as the City of Vinings. The question shall be presented in the form set forth below:

() YES Shall the Act incorporating the City of Vinings in Cobb County according to the charter contained in the Act be approved?"

() NO

All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes", and those persons desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No". If a majority of the voters vote in favor of the question, the question shall be approved, otherwise, it shall be rejected and of no force or effect. The following polling places will be open from 7:00am to 7:00pm for this special election:

NICKAJACK 01: Nickajack Elementary School, 4555 Mavell Rd., Smyrna

VININGS 01: Vinings Library, 4290 Paces Ferry Rd., Atlanta

VININGS 02: Teasley Elementary School, 3640 Spring Hill Pkwy., Smyrna

VININGS 03: King Spring Baptist Church, 3732 King Springs Rd. SE, Smyrna

VININGS 04: Cochise Riverview Clubhouse, 3795 Cochise Dr., Atlanta

Residents of Cobb County who are qualified to register to vote, and are not currently registered, or who need to update their voter registration information, may do so through Monday, April 25, 2022. Residents may register to vote online at www.mvp.sos.ga.gov or at any of the designated places for registering Cobb County residents. Residents who have moved into, out of, or within the proposed city limits of Vinings must update their registration no later than April 25, 2022.

Early In-Person Voting will be available beginning May 2, 2022; hours and locations will be available at www.CobbElections.org.

Voters may apply to Vote-by-Mail by submitting an application between March 7, 2022 and May 13, 2022 to the Cobb County Elections Office at P.O. Box 649, Marietta, GA 30061-0649, or by faxing an application to 770/528-2458, or by emailing as an attachment to absentee@cobbcounty.org. Applications are available at www.CobbElections.org. Voted absentee ballots must be received by Cobb Elections no later than 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 24, 2022 either through the mail or personally delivered to authorized drop-off locations.
