The Cobb County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 12.63 percent.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the Cobb County Board of Commissioners meeting room at 100 Cherokee Street, Marietta, Georgia on Tuesday, July 19, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. and on Tuesday, July 26, 2022, at 7:00 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 8.460 mills, an effective increase of 0.949 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 7.511 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$350,000.00 is approximately \$123.37 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$500,000.00 is approximately \$189.80.
