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Munchkin Camp (ages 3-5 years old) 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Cost: \$35.00 for the week.

This is an introduction to tennis class for beginners or advanced beginner children. We work on hand-eye coordination, basic tennis strokes and play a lot of fun games. Camp participants should bring a tennis racquet, water or sports drink. Dress appropriate for an athletic activity and wear sunscreen.

Future Stars Camp (ages 6-16 years old) 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Cost: \$75.00 for the week.

This group is composed of beginner and intermediate level children. Some may have had tennis lessons before but some may be beginners. We will have a group for total beginners and a group of slightly advanced ones. This is a good place for Tennis Apprentice graduates (those that did one session of Tennis Apprentice in the past). League and tournament players are welcome also.

Competition Camp (ages 10-16 years old) 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Cost: \$105.00 for the week.

This group is for tournament players only. High level drills and point development emphasized. Plyometrics, dynamic stretching introduced to players. We will also have match play each day where we work on strategy.
