



Purpose


- Develop project concepts that improve safety, mobility and access while also preparing for advancement to Project Engineering
- Develop safe, connected, multimodal, and cost-effective solutions to the project trail and to study the feasibility of alternatives
- Criteria and considerations:
 - Consistency with the vision and goals set forth in the County's Comprehensive Transportation Plan, Greenway and Trail Master Plan, and the Atlanta Region's Plan.
 - Maximize safety, connectivity, and efficiency throughout the trail.
 - Potential to address the existing and future needs of pedestrian and bicycle users.
 - Prepare data and materials for the future federal funding eligibility of all project phases.

Austell Powder Springs Trail


Corridor Overview*

- 4.16 Miles in Length
- Roadway ROW 1.93 miles (46.3%)
- Public Land 1.24 miles (29.8%)
- Private Land 0.98 (23.9%)
- Key Destinations:
 - TSilver Comet Trail and Linear Park
 - Clarkdale Park/ Senior Center
 - 🛨 Legion Field
 - Downtown Austell (Near Joe Jerkins Road)


Previous Planning Projects

- Connecting natural areas, parks, schools, civic centers, and businesses to neighborhoods through safe, comfortable, and attractive pedestrian and bicycle linkages.




