This water efficiency incentive program offers a credit on your water bill for the purchase of ultra-high efficiency toilets in homes and business built prior to 1993. With nearly 30% of the average household's indoor water consumption used for toilets, replacing older toilets will save water and money. If you think you have a leak in your home or have had higher than normal monthly usage and are wondering where your water is going, CCWS offers a Leak Detector Loaner Program for our customers. A Flume Smart Home Water Monitor can be checked out for up to 90 days to track your real-time water use. The Flume Water Sensor straps easily around your water meter and communicates water use in real-time to the Flume app through a WiFi bridge inside your home.
