Expectations for Students

As students develop in revelatory experiences, they are encouraged to practice the following principles:

- Honor Scripture
- God's Word remains the highest authority.
- Remain Humble
- No individual possesses complete understanding.

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- Be Teachable
 - Remain open to learning and correction.
 - Practice Discernment
 - Test and evaluate experiences carefully.
 - Avoid Dogmatic Interpretations
 - Allow room for continued prayer and understanding.
 - Respect Others
 - Honor differing perspectives and experiences.
 - Maintain Confidentiality
 - Handle personal revelations shared within the community responsibly.
 - Pursue Spiritual Maturity
 - Focus on growth rather than spiritual appearance.
