

Lawn Care Program

August (Start of school)

Fertilize with Turfbuilder with Fire Ant control
Insect control and weed control

September

Water regularly

October (First week of month)

Fertilize with Turfbuilder with Winter Guard
Dethatch, rake and aereate

November (Football play-offs)

Mow lower
Aereate
Overseed
 OF - rye grass at 6 – 8 # per 1,000' in two
 Directions
 IF – rye grass at 25 # per 1,000' in five
 Directions

December

Mow high and fertilize

January – February (Before baseball season)

Lower mowing height
Turfbuilder with Halts Crabgrass Preventer
Weed control when temp is 60 degrees or higher
Insect control

March (Spring Break)

Fertilize with Turfbuilder Plus 2% Weed Control

May (Start of Play-offs)

Dethatch and Weed control
Plant new grass (Bermuda is 2 # per 1,000')
Starter fertilizer

June (First week of summer)

Fertilize with Turfbuilder with Summer Guard
Insect control
Weed control

July (Independence Day)

Water 1" three days a week

Watering

- * 1" per watering
- * To check for watering value – poke a screwdriver into the soil. If it goes 6 – 8" then watering is good. Less than 6 – 8" need to water more.
- * Water in the early morning

Mowing

$\frac{3}{4}$ " – 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
Change patterns every time you mow
Use a roller to create stripes
Reel mower is best

Edge and Hoe Infield

1st and 3rd week of each month

Drag Infield and Water Infield

Daily

Aerate

Monthly – First Friday of month in off season
