Main Scripture: (Feel free to use another bible version)

"...for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure." – (Philippians 2:13)

Main Truths:

- We should depend on God's power and ability working through us...and not on our own talent and ability.
- We should always give our best effort to please God.
- We should always make sure that our hearts are pure because God looks at our hearts...not on what we look like on the outside.

Learning Objectives:

- 1. After this lesson, children will learn that they should depend on God's ability and power working through them...and not to depend on their own ability and talents.
- 2. The children will also develop a stronger desire to pray to God and ask Him to work through them by the Holy Spirit.
- 3. Children will learn that God looks at the motives of their hearts and not on what they look like on the outside.




Color These!


