Oncology Foundations for the Pelvic Health Rehab Clinician

Course Description:

This 10.5-hour course is designed for pelvic health rehab clinicians to gain knowledge on foundational cancer concepts and the role of pelvic health rehab for cancer survivors. This course focuses on cancer epidemiology and disparities, cancer pathophysiology, cancer diagnosis and treatment, the role of rehab along the cancer continuum, review of systems and objective examination, exercise prescription for cancer survivors, and wellness and health promotion. This is a didactic course with multiple case studies; no labs are included. All modules and case examples are pelvic cancer focused.

**The intermediate OncoPelvic PT course, "Pelvic Oncology Rehabilitation", will go in-depth for each pelvic cancer including specific diagnosis and treatments, pelvic health evaluation and focused treatment interventions, and lab videos. Taking the "Oncology Foundations for the Pelvic Health Rehab Clinician" course, or similar basic/general oncology course, is required as a pre-requisite to take the "Pelvic Oncology Rehabilitation" course.
