How to build your website on Podia

Use this checklist to build your beautiful Podia website! By the end, you'll have a homepage, one additional page, a custom header and footer, and a unique website domain.


Before you start, grab your Podia account here. Podia websites are included on all plans, and you can start building during your 30-day free trial.

🟠 Build your home page
Open the <u>Podia website builder</u> . Click "Site" in the top menu and select "Edit site." By default, the builder opens to your website homepage.
Add a section to your home page. Click the plus sign anywhere on the page to add a new section. A section menu will come up in the left sidebar. (Not sure where to start? Try adding a bio section with your profile image, name, and some info about yourself.)
■ Write your section content. In the "Content" tab, add any titles, images, text, buttons, or grid items to your section. You can type directly into the sidebar sections or paste your content in, and you'll see your changes take effect in your website area.
Customize your section design. In the "Design" tab, adjust the image styles, layout, appearance, and background color/image of your section.
□ Add additional sections to your homepage. Click the plus sign above or below any section to add another section. Add as many sections as you like to complete your homepage.

 Adjust your homepage settings. Click on "Homepage" in the top left corner and select the gear icon next to your homepage. Add a page title, description, and social image.
☐ Toggle on "Show in search results." Use this feature if you'd like your page to appear when people use search engines.
☐ Click "Publish" to make your page live. Or you can click "Done" to save your work.


Set your sitewide settings These settings will take effect everywhere on your site. You can override these settings in each section. Set your sitewide colors. Click the "Design" tab in the top menu and select "Colors." Click on "Base colors" to pick a premade color palette or add your own. Set your sitewide font. Under the "Design" tab in the top menu, select "Fonts." You can choose a preset font combination or pick each font individually in the style section. Set your sitewide interactive settings. Under the "Design" tab in the top menu, select "Interactives." You can style your links, navigation links, linked titles, buttons, and social icons. Set your sitewide media preferences. Under the "Design" tab in the top menu, select "Media." Here you can adjust the design and layout of your images and videos.

☐ Set your sitewide structure. Under the "Design" tab in the top menu, select "Structure." You can adjust the width, gap padding, and card style.

Set up your header and footer Click into the header section of your website in the Podia website builder. ☐ **Upload your logo** if you'd like it to appear in the header navigation. ☐ Add links to your most important pages ☐ Toggle the "Show Login" button on or off depending on your preference. This button lets people log into their accounts and access courses and products they've bought. ☐ Click on the "Design" tab to customize your layout, appearance, colors, and header width. Click into the footer section of your website in the Podia website builder. ☐ **Upload your logo** if you'd like it to appear in your footer. ☐ Add a short description of your business in the text box. ☐ **Add links** to any pages you'd like to display in your footer. ☐ Add links to your social media pages. Copy and paste the full link to your profile from any platforms you use. ☐ Show an email form in your footer by adding a title, button, and success message. ☐ Click on the "Design" tab to adjust the style of your footer.
