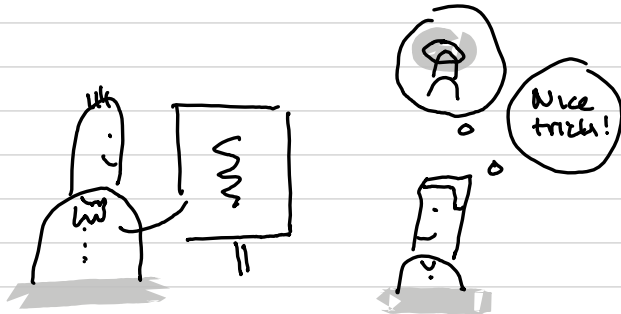


## A few things I love about studying
