

Old Testament Treasures Overview

From the Hebrew mindset, the Old Testament is broken into three sections (Torah, Nevi'im, Ketuvim) which gives us the name Tanakh (also spelled Tanak).

Torah – God's instructions, also called "the law"

Nevi'im – the prophets

Ketuvim – the writings

You will see it referred to in the New Testament as "the Law and the Prophets" or "the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms" (Luke 24:44).

Torah – Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy

Nevi'im – Joshua, Judges, Samuel, Kings, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel and "The Twelve"

Ketuvim – Psalms, Job, Proverbs, Ruth, S of S, Eccl, Lamentations, Esther, Daniel, Ezra-Nehemiah, Chronicles (this order is different according to some, but it always starts with Psalms and ends with Chronicles)

The six covenants covered in this series are: Noahic, Abrahamic, Mosaic, Levitical, Davidic, and the New.

The words covered in this series are: holy (qadosh), law (torah), faith (emunah), and righteousness (tzaddik).

The roles covered in this series are: prophet, priest, and king.

The places covered in sacred space are the garden, the Tabernacle, and the Temple.
