## How to start blogging on Podia

This checklist will help you get your Podia blog set up quickly. Before you start, **grab your free Podia account here**. Blogging is free on all plans.

🎨 Customize your blog	
Click on "Blog" in the left menu of the Podia website builder. This takes you to your archive page, a single page where visitors can look through all your blog content.	
Click on the "Posts" section. Add a heading, description, and any buttons you like.	
Under "Options," choose which data you'd like to show. Toggle on or off the featured image, date, author, comment count, excerpt, and button. This will apply to all blog post entries.	
Click on the "Design" tab. This is where you can set the image style, layout, background, and appearance of your blog post entries.	
Add additional content to your blog archive page. You can click the plus sign anywhere on the page to add an email opt-in form, featured image, author bio, or other information.

Customize individual blog post pages
Click on "Blog Post" in the left menu of the Podia website builder. This is where you can adjust the design of individual blog articles.
In the "Post Heading" section, decide which data you'd like to show. Toggle on or off the featured image, date, author, comment count, and excerpt.

🔆 Last steps to build your Podia blog
Delete any filler content by going to <u>"Blog" in the upper menu and clicking "Blog posts."</u> Next to the blog post you'd like to delete, click the three dots and choose "Delete post."
Customize your website and blog domain. Go to " <u>Settings" and click "Domains</u> ." You can add a Podia subdomain for free, or connect your own custom domain on the Starter plan and above.
Add a link to your blog in the header and/or footer of your Podia website.
Proofread your blog posts. And check to make sure all the buttons go where you want them to go.
Press "Done" to save your work or "Publish" to turn it live.
