Course Title:

Pelvic Health Foundations for the Oncology Rehab Provider

Course Description:

This 5.5-hour online course is designed for oncology rehab providers to improve their understanding of pelvic health conditions experienced among cancer survivors. This self-paced course focuses on pelvic floor disorders, pelvic cancers, how pelvic cancer treatment can lead to pelvic floor disorders, and how to screen and implement initial management strategies for cancer survivors experiencing pelvic health concerns.
