Question: Who is this course for?

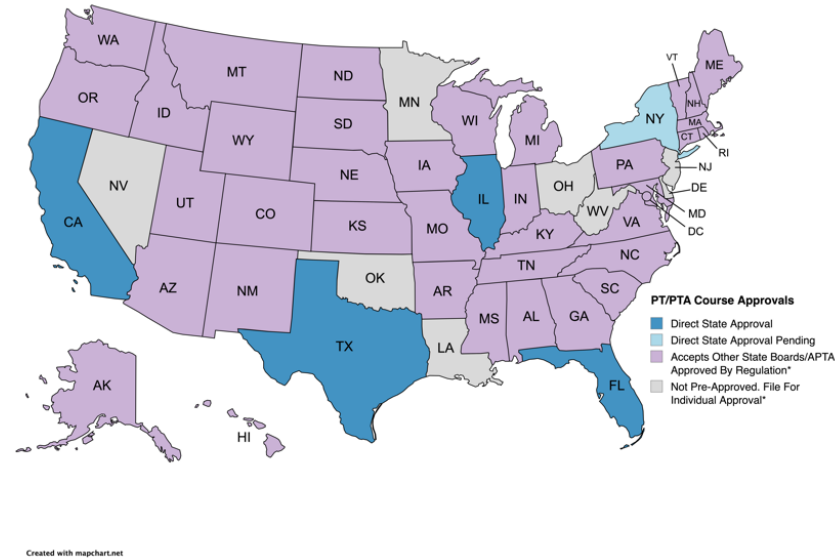
Question: Do I get continuing education units (CEUs) with this course?
