
TEACHER'S LESSON PLAN





Teacher's Instructions:

This lesson is flexible so you can change it to fit the needs, understanding and age range of your students. You can change and delete questions...and you can even write your own questions and activities.

- Remember, this entire curriculum is a basic guideline to teach your students. You're free to follow the leading of the Lord in how you teach the lessons.
- Attached to this lesson, you'll find the Student's Activity Worksheets. Make as many copies (color or black/white) as you need.
- Pray before each class session and ask for the Lord's help, wisdom and anointing over you and the kids.

Main Scripture: (Feel free to use another bible version)

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths." – Proverbs 3:5-6

Main Truths:

- 1. The importance of praying (talking with) to God and asking Him for help and guidance.
- 2. It's very important to stay close to God by spending time with (and talking with) God every day.

Learning Objectives:

- After this lesson, children will learn what prayer is and why it's so important. They will learn to establish prayer as a habit in their own lives.
- The children will develop a strong desire for prayer and spending intimate time with God.
- This lesson will help children understand how praying can be a normal part of their daily lives. God can be their best friend and closest helper in tough situations.
- Children will learn that God is our ultimate source of help in time of trouble. They will understand that we can trust God for help because He cares for us.
- Children will understand that we should pray for help and praise God through prayer so we're prepared for the enemy's attacks on our spirituality.

Video Discussion Questions: (write your answers)

1. What did Dex do when he went into his bedroom?

Answer: Dex prayed when he went into his bedroom

2. What did he pray about?

Answer: Dex prayed and asked God to help show him what to do. Should he tell the truth or not say anything at all.

3. What would happen if Dex DID told Mr. Slater who did it?

Answer: Dex would be obeying God by telling the truth, but he probably would get beat up by JD.

4. What would happen if Dex DID NOT tell Mr. Slater who did it?

Answer: Dex and the whole class would get suspended for three (3) weeks...and Dex would be covering up a sin because of fear of getting beat up by JD.

5. What scripture did God show to Dex?

Answer: Ephesians 4:25

Group Discussion Questions:



1. What is Prayer?

Answer: Prayer is talking with God. It's not just talking TO God...and it's also listening to hear what God says back to you. It's communicating with God.

2. Why should we pray?

Answer: We should pray because we love God and want to talk to Him everyday. We should pray because we want to be in a close, intimate relationship with God...He's our Father and he loves us, and we love Him. Plus, God guides and leads us when we pray to him.

3. Does God answer our prayers? How has God answered your prayers? Give an example of a prayer that God answered for you.

Answer: Yes, God answers our prayers. They may not always be "YES", but he does answer.

4. Why is it important to pray and ask God for help?

Answer: It's important because God knows everything and He wants to help us and lead us in the right direction for our good. So we should pray and talk to him so we can depend on him for help...and not on our own.


