Question: Who is this course for?

Question: Do I get continuing education units (CEUs) with this course?

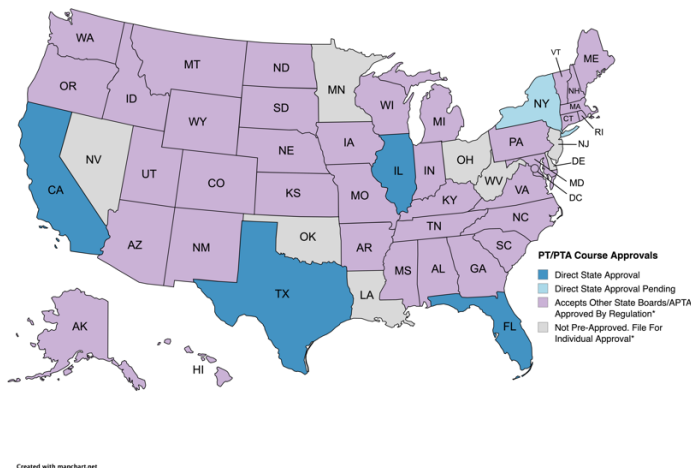

Answer: No! There is no internal (vaginal or rectal) assessment and treatment that you need to do in this course. One module does include what internal examination and treatment looks like for pelvic health providers so you are better equipped to educate your patients and colleagues. This course does NOT make you a pelvic health therapist.
