Fortunate are those who come across a Gnani in their very life-time. Still more fortunate are those who recognise him for what he is and benefit from his divine association. One such Brahma Gnani is Yogi Ramsuratkumar, in whom thousands of people have found solace, succor and shanti in life.

Born on December 1, 1918, Yogi Ramsuratkumar was a hidden saint who lived as a beggar on the streets of Tiruvannamalai, Tamil Nadu. In His quest for a Guru and the Truth, He travelled to South India where He met His three Gurus : Sri Aurobindo, Ramana Maharishi and Papa Ramdas. Papa Ramdas initiated him into “Om Sri Ram Jai Ram Jai Jai Ram” and said, “Go and repeat it day and night, all the twenty four hours.” In the course of seven days and seven nights, Ramsuratkumar made the great exodus from the Kingdom of man to the Kingdom of God. Ramsuratkumar became YOGI RAMSURATKUMAR, a savior of ignorant souls with a mission greater than his own liberation. Today, His Name, YOGI RAMSURATKUMAR provides help, guidance and protection to all those who chant it and is a sanctuary of peace, love and joy.

Ma Devaki, whom Sri Yogiji called His eternal slave, served Him personally for seven years until His Mahasamadhi in 2001. Mataji has continued her seva at His Ashram in Tiruvannamalai for the past twenty three years. Mataji is here with us today, to share her experiences with the Great Yogi. She brings alive His teachings which are very relevant to modern life and accentuates the glory of chanting His Name in a way that touches and transforms lives.

Ma Devaki Mataji is a Life Trustee of the Yogi Ramsuratkumar Ashram and the Ma Devaki Veda Patashala Tiruvannamalai.

Ma Devaki personally served Yogi Ramsuratkumar for seven years until His Mahasamadhi in 2001 and has continued her seva at the Tiruvannamalai Ashram ever since. Her mission is to spread His Divine Name and teachings across the world, bringing seekers into the fold and keeping them rooted in God thru Nama and Guru Seva.



Ma Devaki taught Quantum Physics at the Sarada College in Salem for 20 years. A popular professor, she loved her profession and enjoyed engaging with her students.

Being spiritually inclined from a very young age, she always knew that her life would be one in the service of God. She travelled across India, upto the Himalayas in search of Saints and Masters and had the darshan of many great souls. She was closely associated with the Ramkrishna Math and received Her first initiation from Sri Swami Vireshvaranandaji, the then President of Ramakrishna Math, Belur. Soon after that He attained Mahasamadhi. That left a huge vacuum in her and She longed for the physical company of a Master like Sri Ramkrishna. Her spiritual quest led her to Sri Ramana Maharishi. She was greatly inspired by His teachings and that drew her to Tiruvannamalai. She visited Ramana Ashram in the Christmas holidays of 1986 when She heard of a living Master who lived at Arunachala.

On December 27, 1986, Ma had her first and momentous Darshan of Our Bhagwan Shri Yogi Ramsuratkumar in whose huge divine presence She had a very deep spiritual experience and finally felt that her search for her Guru, a wait of several lifetimes was finally over. She had arrived at His Lotus Feet ! Yogi Ramsuratkumar declared that day – Devaki is a pure soul, Devaki will see God ! Her life was never the same again !

Thereafter, for the next 7 years She made frequent visits to Tiruvannamalai helplessly to have His Darshan every week end. Her yearning to be close to Bhagwan became so intense that in 1993, She went on to renounce her work and family and move to Tiruvannamalai, to dedicate herself to the sacred Feet of the Divine Master, only to be in His service forever.

The path to this fulfilment was filled with trials and tribulations but with her Guru Maharaj's Grace, She displayed a rare grit and determination to serve Her Guru whole heartedly.

Bhagwan declared “Devaki is my eternal slave” and named her Ma Devaki, as we all know her today. Ma with a pure heart, stands as an exemplary personification of love, the Supreme Spirit of surrender, devotional service and self-sacrifice. Ma, our beloved Mother, is a great inspiration to all of us. She is truly a candle that burns at both ends !
