**Craft instructions and

Lesson 1: The joy of belonging

"Before" booklet

Need:

- 1 book completed to show children
- 1 printout per child
- Coloured pencils, scissors, glue sticks



- Show how the completed book looks.
- Give each child a set of pages and ask them to colour the pictures.
- Cut out, glue the two pieces together and fold the paper so that "Before Adam and Eve" is topmost picture.

Lesson 2: The joy of being known

Decorate sheep

Need:

- Printout picture per child
- White kite paper/paper tissues
- Glue sticks/paper glue
- Coloured pencils/crayons



- Children rip the kite paper/tissue papers into small pieces and scrunch them in to balls. They then apply a thin layer of glue on the sheep's body and stick the paper balls on.
- They can colour the surrounding areas with coloured pencils/crayons

Lesson 3: The joy of hearing God

Sombrero Hats

Need:

- Example hat to show children
- Sombrero printout per child (could be cutout in advance for smaller children)
- ½ sheet of chart paper per child
- Coloured pencils, crayons etc
- Scissors, glues, stapler and staples/sticky tape
- Each child colours their sombrero hat printout in bright colours.
- Cut out the hat and glue onto chart paper. Allow to dry and then cut around the hat. (You may choose to prepare these in advance).
- Make a headband for each child using a strip of chart paper to fit the child's head, fasten with staples/tape (staples should have their open ends on the outside of the paper to prevent scratching heads or pulling hair).
- Staple the centre of the sombrero hat onto the front of the headband.
- Ask children to write their name inside the headband.
- Keep safe for the fiesta time!

Need:

- Completed book to show
- 1 Printout per child
- Coloured pencils
- Scissors, glue sticks



- Show the memory verse book to the children and explain how important it is for us to learn Bible verses.
- Give each child a printout to colour and then cut out. Glue together and fold the book.

Joy pictures

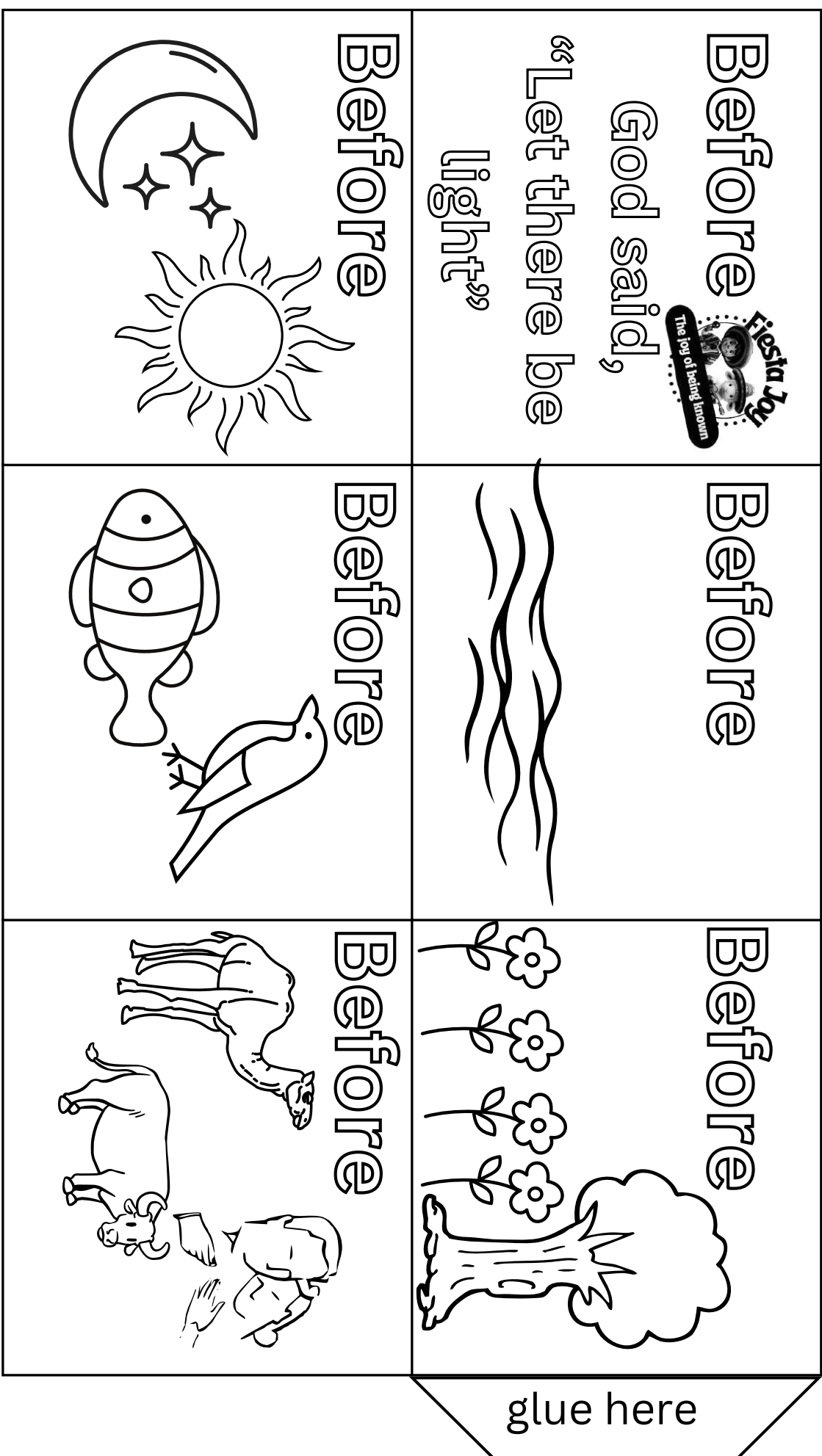
Need:

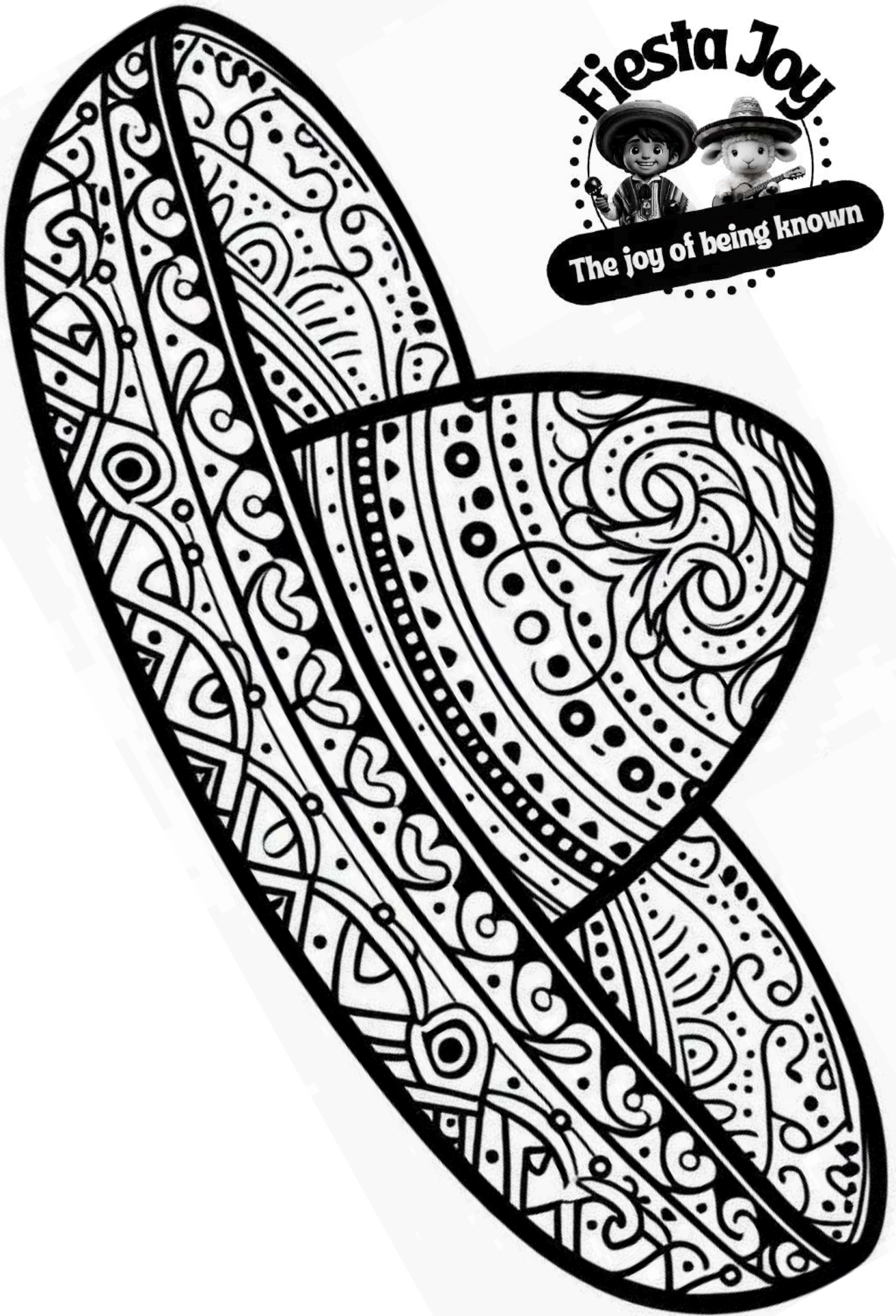
