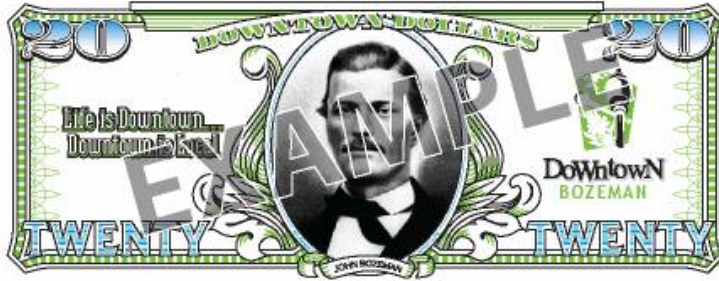


Purchasing Downtown Dollars (D\$)



FOR THE SHOPPER:

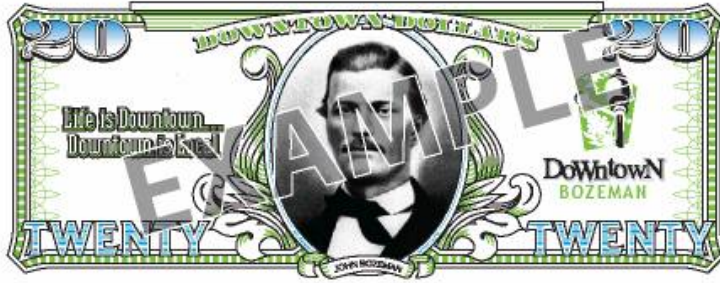
Downtown Dollars are a gift certificate good anywhere in Downtown Bozeman. From your favorite shopping retailer, to bars and restaurants, spa treatments, professional services and more - it's truly the gift for everyone and every occasion!

Downtown Dollars can be purchased in 5, 10, and 20 denominations both [online](#) via credit card* and by cash or check at the below locations:

- First Security Bank's downtown location at 208 East Main Street
- First Security Bank's 19th location at 670 South 19th Avenue
- The Downtown Bozeman Partnership Office at 222 East Main Street, Suite 302
- ERA/Downtown Visitor Center at 8 East Main Street

Accepting Downtown Dollars (D\$)



FOR THE BUSINESS:

Downtown Dollars are essentially cash. Your business accepts them as cash and exchanges them at a 1:1 rate to the DBA for a check!

Downtown Dollars are a powerful community economic stimulus tool as they support locally owned independent businesses. Over 60 cents of every physical dollar that is spent at a downtown business is reinvested into the community; compare that to less than 20 cents of every dollar spent at a national chain, and it's easy to see why D\$ are such a mutually beneficial and successful program!

Many businesses find success in treating D\$ as cash in their POS system and giving back cash change**, if applicable.

We're happy to exchange D\$ upon request. Many businesses will wait until they collect a large sum and then reach out. We typically are available to cut checks onsite twice a week; save summer event season where we are intermittently available.

Fraudulence:

**Please be aware of purchases made with Downtown Dollars with the intent of getting a large sum of cash back. You as the business are not responsible for paying out D\$, nor is that a possibility. D\$ are to be treated in the same manner as a gift card.

Downtown Dollars are printed on “kan’t kopy” paper with visible voids. There is one central printing location and a unique design distributed exclusively by the Downtown Bozeman Association.
