[Downtown Bozeman Trick-or-Treating](#) will be taking place on Friday, October 31st

from 4-6 PM and we are inviting Bozeman families to head downtown for a spooktacular and safe evening of traditional Trick-or-Treating at downtown businesses. We can't wait to see downtown filled with costumes, candy, and community spirit!

This year's event includes a few important updates to enhance safety and organization. Please read carefully:

MAIN STREET CLOSURE – Due to growing safety concerns surrounding the size and popularity of this event, the City of Bozeman has deemed a full street closure necessary to ensure a safe, family-friendly environment for all participants.

- **Main Street will be closed to vehicle traffic from Grand to Church from approximately 3–7 PM.**
 - No-parking signage will be placed in advance along the closure route.
 - **Any vehicles still parked when the event begins will need to remain in place until it concludes.**
- The intent of this closure is public safety, not a festival. This remains a family event centered on kids and community.
 - Any concerns should be directed to [Shane Brandhorst](#) with the Bozeman Fire Department.

PARTICIPATION DETAILS FOR BUSINESSES – We'd love for you to participate by handing out Halloween candy (or other fun goodies!) to kids and families from 4–6 PM.

A few tips to help make the event safe and enjoyable for all:

- **Expect around 3,500 attendees and have roughly 1,500 individual treats ready.**
- Please set up outside your business, many attendees are young children or parents with strollers.
 - Maintain 6' of sidewalk clearance for ADA compliance.
 - Remove outdoor furniture and sandwich boards during the event to ease congestion.
- Non-Profits may request to set up outside your business; this is a great chance to team up!
- **We encourage costumes and decorations!**
 - The top 3 businesses will be featured on our platforms! Please keep all decorations and costumes family-friendly.
