RESOLUTION 2021-U

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, REPEALING RESOLUTION 1998-B AND SETTING THE FEE FOR FINGERPRINTING SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Eatonville Town Council approved Resolution 1998-B on January 26, 1998 establishing a fee for fingerprinting for Town residents as well as those living outside the town limits; and

WHEREAS, the Eatonville Police Department provides the service of fingerprinting to the public at large, and this service should be documented, and a fee collected to cover the costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, the fee set by Resolution 1998-B is still currently in line with other local entities, and the Town wishes to establish a per card fee as well as offer the same fee for residents and non-residents; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee met on June 9, 2021 and discussed setting the fee at \$10.00 for the first card and \$3.00 per additional card and recommends adoption of Resolution 2021-U; and

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Resolution 1998-B is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: The following fees are hereby established to recover costs to the Town for fingerprinting services: \$10.00 for the first fingerprint card \$3.00 for each subsequent card

<u>Section 2:</u> The Town Clerk shall periodically review and recommend additional fees and charges, or amendments to the above listed fees to assure recovery of the costs for providing fingerprinting services.
