RESOLUTION 2021-X

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CORONAVIRUS RECOVERY FUNDS FOR A FINGERPRINT SCANNER

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA") was signed into law, and established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, which together make up the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds ("SLFRF") program; and

WHEREAS, ARPA provides a total of \$350 billion in emergency funding for eligible state, local, territorial and Tribal governments; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville's total allocation of ARPA funds is \$844,702.00, with 50% provided in June 2021 and the balance 12 months later; and

WHEREAS, the Eatonville Police Department provides concealed weapons permits and fingerprinting services and purchased an electronic fingerprint scanner to allow for an easier process and less physical contact between staff and applicants; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of this fingerprint scanner qualifies as an approved use of ARPA funds; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee met and discussed the use of ARPA funds to cover the cost of the fingerprint scanner and recommends approval of reimbursing the Town for this cost from those funds; and

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

THAT: The Town of Eatonville is authorized to reimburse the purchase of the fingerprint scanner in the amount of \$11,927.76 from the Town's allocation of American Rescue Plan Act funds.
