RESOLUTION 2023-HH

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR \$200,000 IN USDOT FEDERAL FUNDING FOR A SAFETY ACTION PLAN THROUGH PUGET SOUND REGIONAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Regional Council has been awarded USDOT <u>Safe Streets</u> For All (SS4A) funding for distribution to eligible agencies and municipalities in Pierce County; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville seeks a \$200,000 grant for completion and approval of a Safety Action Plan that will serve to make the Town eligible for future federally funded safety design and construction projects; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the grant, the Town has a \$50,000 (20%) grant match requirement but staff time dedicated to the development of the Safety Action Plan will qualify as matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is supportive of a comprehensive safety analysis of the streets and roads within the Town with the goal of eliminating fatalities and serious injury; now, therefore.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

THAT: The Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and staff to pursue a \$200,000 SS4A grant and commits to meeting the \$50,000 (20%) match requirement of the total \$250,000 project cost to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for the Town of Eatonville.
