

RESOLUTION 2026-KK

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville has multiple vehicles and equipment that are not used and are surplus to the Town's needs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to surplus the vehicles and equipment listed herein and authorize the Town of Eatonville to dispose of them by live auction; and

WHEREAS, none of the surplus vehicles have a value over \$50,000, therefore, no public hearing is required for declaring the property surplus; and

WHEREAS, the Town will hold a one-day live auction with all proceeds from the sale of the surplus property deposited into the corresponding fund; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council gives authority to the Mayor to dispose of any surplus property remaining after the live auction by way of junk vehicle removal; now, therefore

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:
