Monthly Job Report – July 2026

Water Department

In July, the Water Department treated and produced approximately **15.6 million gallons** of water. Thanks to the dedication of our staff, the town's water supply met or exceeded all federal and state standards, with no service interruptions or exceedances.

- Five water leaks were repaired.
- Summer high demand is in full swing.

Key Statistics:

- 108 water samples collected
- 147 lab tests performed

Wastewater Department

The Wastewater Treatment Plant processed **4.75 million gallons** of wastewater. All test results met or exceeded federal and state limits, and no permit violations occurred.

- Our new draft NPDES permit is still in the public comment phase.
- The streambank armoring project is continuing full steam ahead.

Key Statistics:

- 133 wastewater samples collected
- 504 lab tests performed

Public Works

Public Works continued its efforts to maintain and improve town infrastructure:

- Water perk testing and soil tests on Penn Ave and Ridge Rd.
- Fourth of July prep was a success.
- Brush mowing is happening on the trail and around town.
