What do I need to know about getting vaccinated?



All immigrants can get vaccinated.

You don't need a social security number or immigration status to get vaccinated for COVID.



You do not need a government-issued ID or a letter from your employer to get a vaccine.

The COVID vaccine is free.

The vaccine is free for everyone, regardless of immigration status.



Getting the vaccine will not impact your current or future immigration status, and you won't be asked about your immigration status.

It is NOT considered in a public charge test.



Your information is safe.

Your medical information is private and will not be shared with immigration officials.
