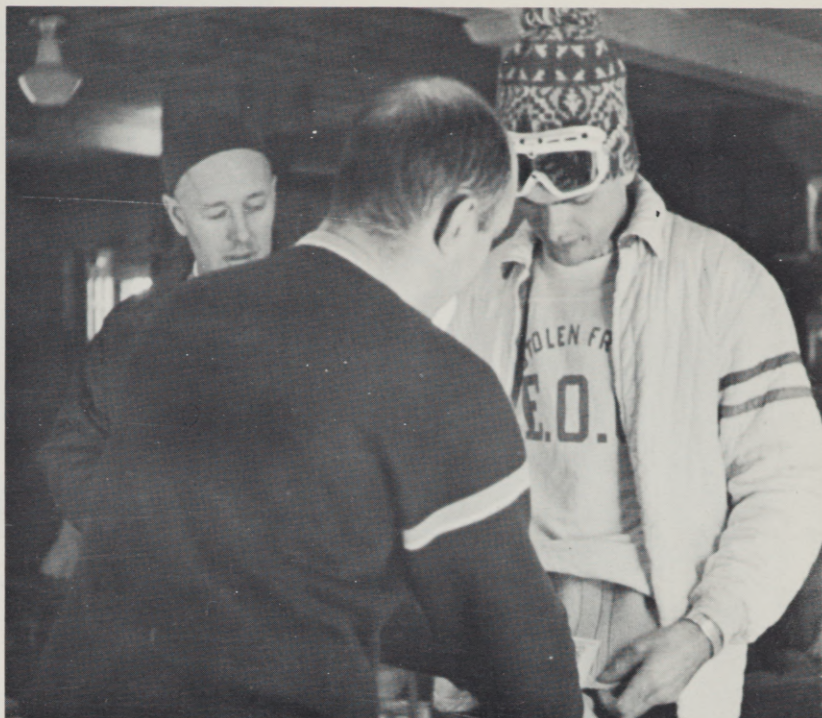

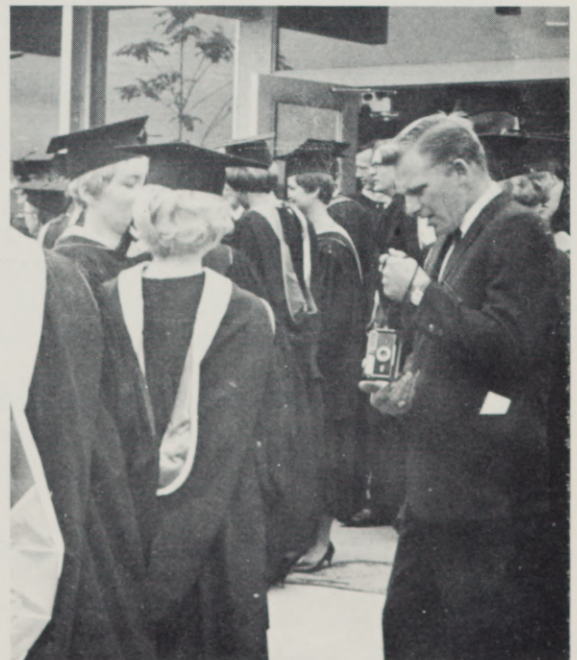

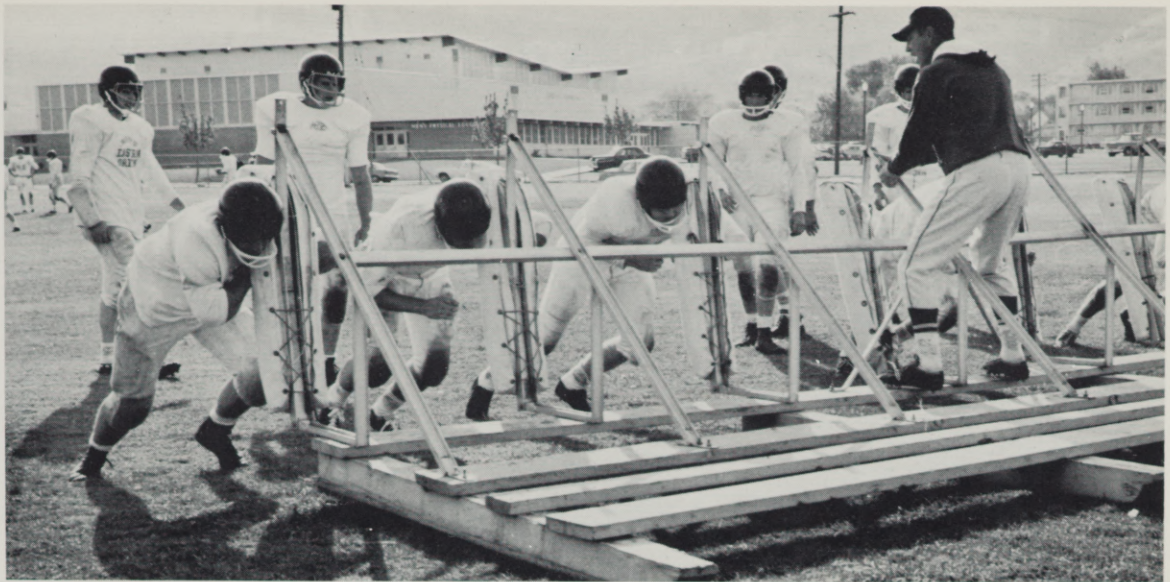

RECORD 15 WINS, 1 LOSS

This year's Mountaineer squad broke almost every possible record. The '65-'66 squad tied the Oregon Collegiate Conference scoring record of 15 wins and 1 loss. The team also posted the longest winning streak ever attained by a Mountaineer squad in the history of Eastern Oregon College. 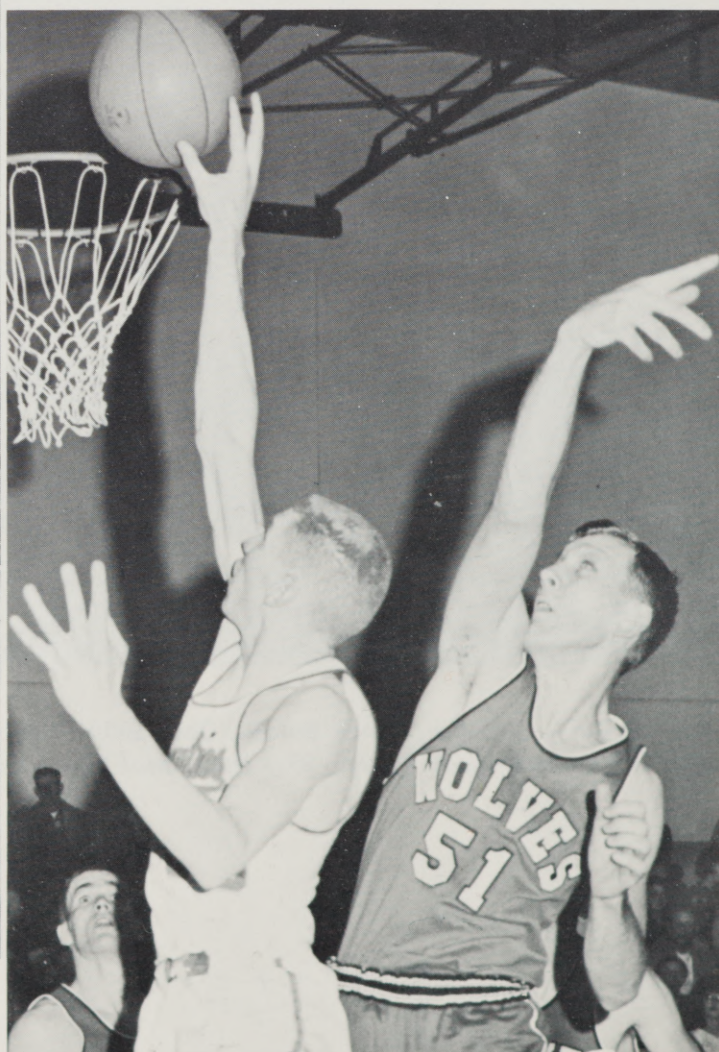

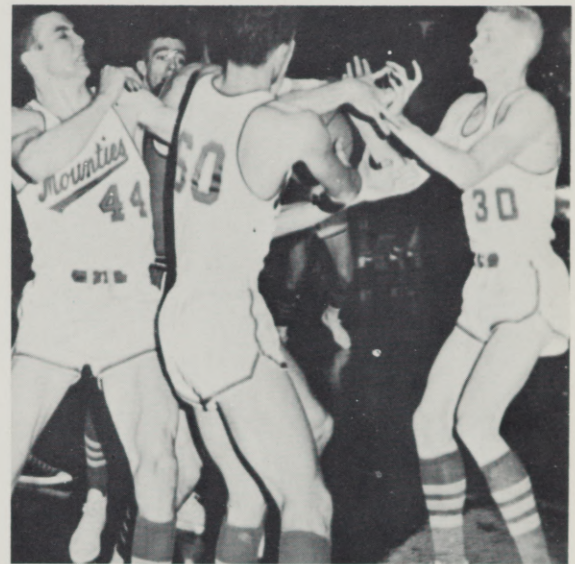

This year, "Odie's" team captured the Oregon Collegiate Conference Championship and the District 2 N.A.I.A. Championship.

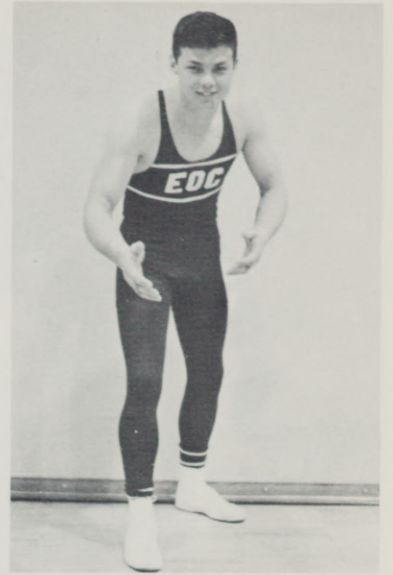

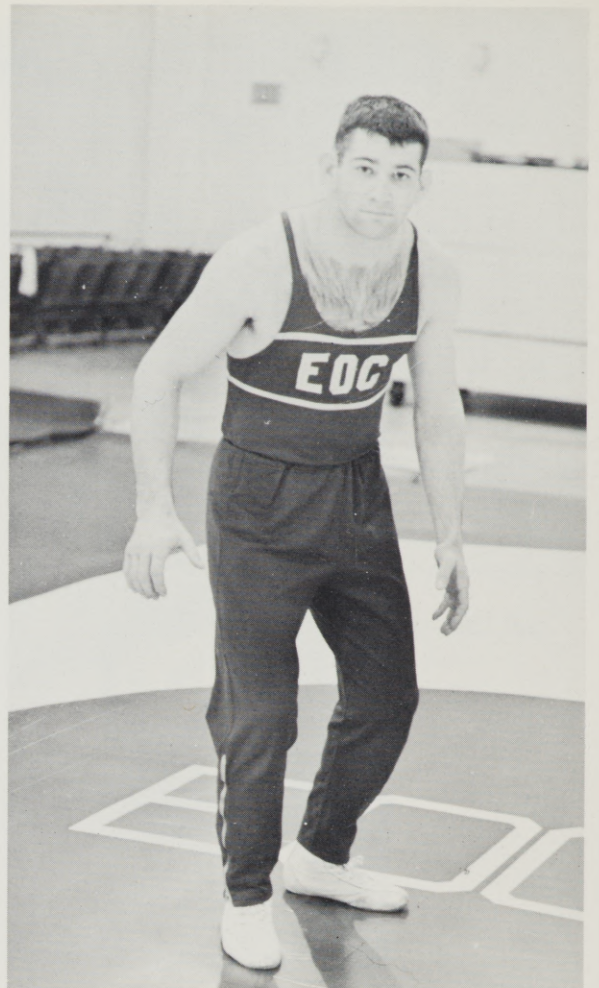

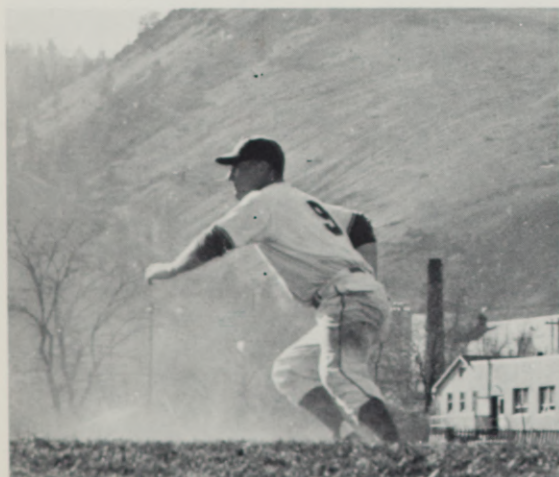

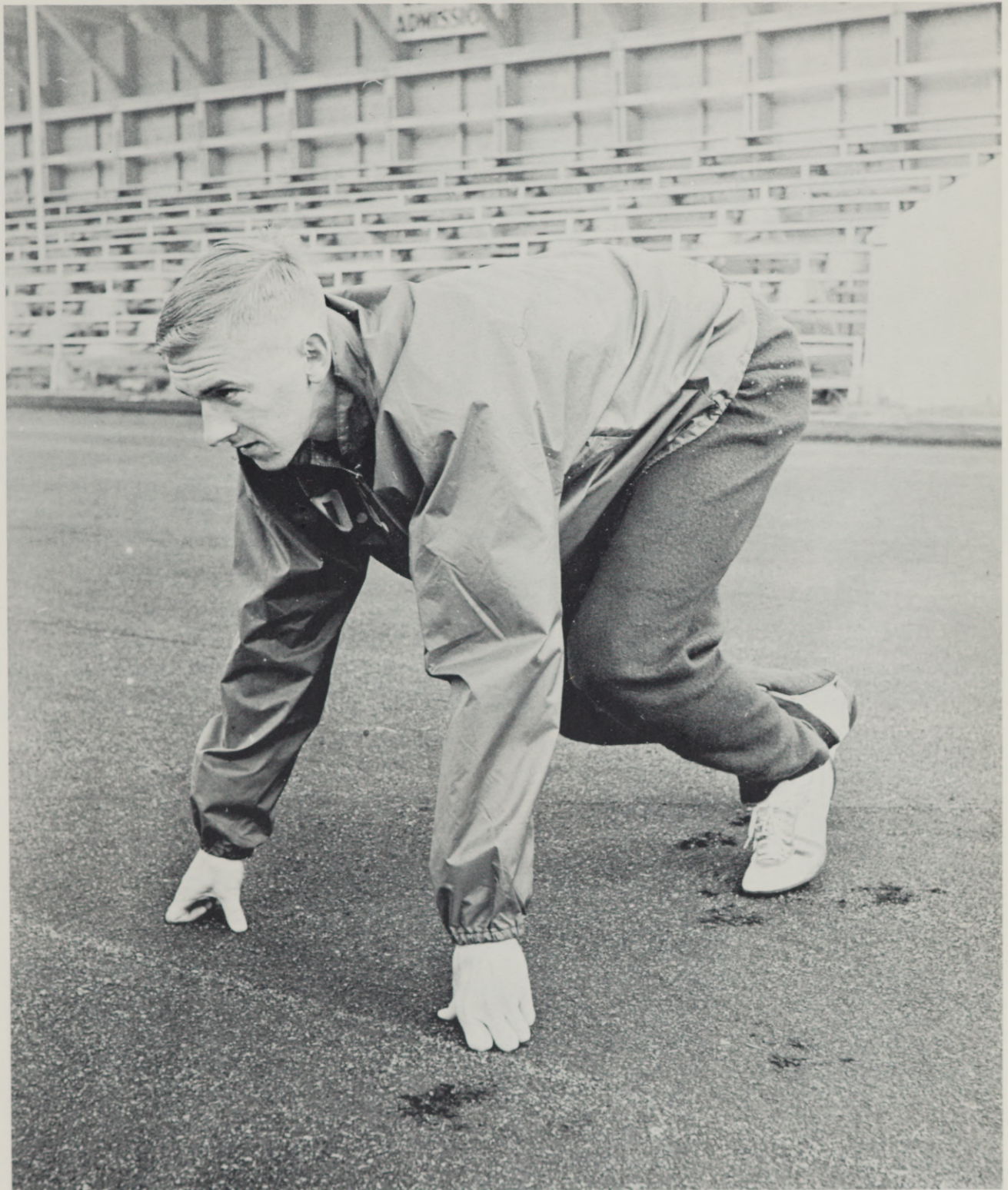
