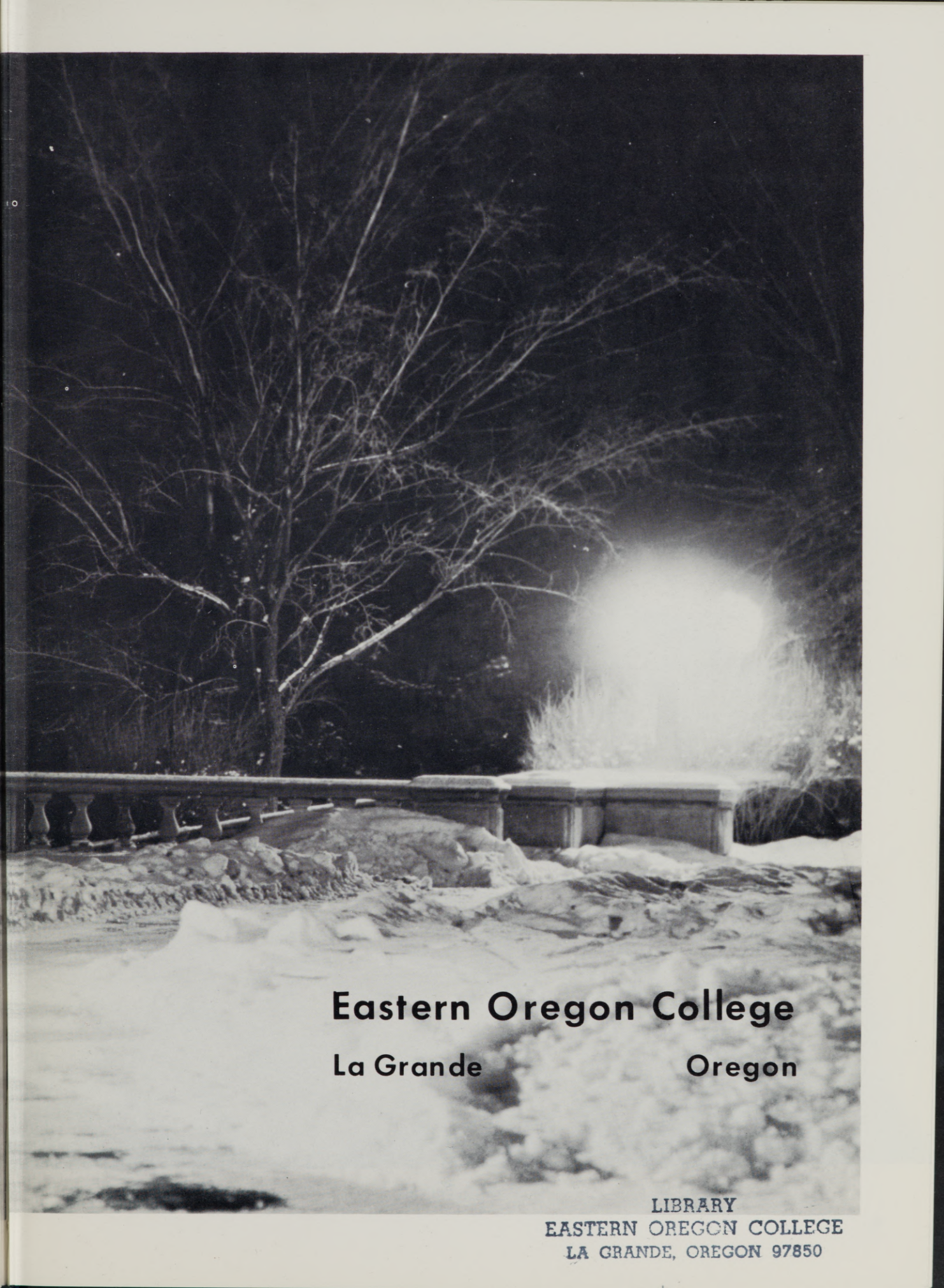

President's Message

Year by year in my report through the annual, I have tried to detail briefly the major developments at the college. We have from time to time recounted curriculum changes, student and staff increases, buildings added, and new directions under consideration and contemplated.

Because of my anticipated retirement this August after, for me, twelve wonderful years at Eastern Oregon College and a total of forty-four years in teaching and school administration, I wish in this report to point up two major considerations.

The first consideration has to do with my appreciation for all that I inherited as I came to Eastern Oregon College. The student, alumni, and staff loyalty and quality, the traditions, the small beginnings grown stronger, the faith and hope of citizens and supporters—these spoke eloquently of the contributions of all who had worked together under and within the administrations of the four former presidents at Eastern Oregon College.

The second consideration has to do with my wish to pass on to my successor and your new president all that Eastern Oregon College has become and now is, with our commitment together of good will and complete cooperation to his leadership. Such commitment on the part of students, faculty, alumni, and citizens will be the solid basis on which the future of Eastern Oregon College will be built. Doors are ajar to real progress for growth in numbers, campus, building, and the material evidence of an institution. More important, however, doors are ajar to real progress in the scope, breadth, depth, and quality of the college's offerings and therefore and thereby, to capacity of the college to serve the vast Eastern Oregon region so long slighted at the college level and seemingly forgotten.

From my new and somewhat untried avocational interests and occupations, I shall watch with hope and great faith the developments yet to be. I will thrill with you in your successes, sorrow with you in your disappointments, and applaud your achievements. Eastern Oregon College, in a very real way, now becomes my Alma Mater, and I shall ever remain bound with you in our common hopes and faith in her future.

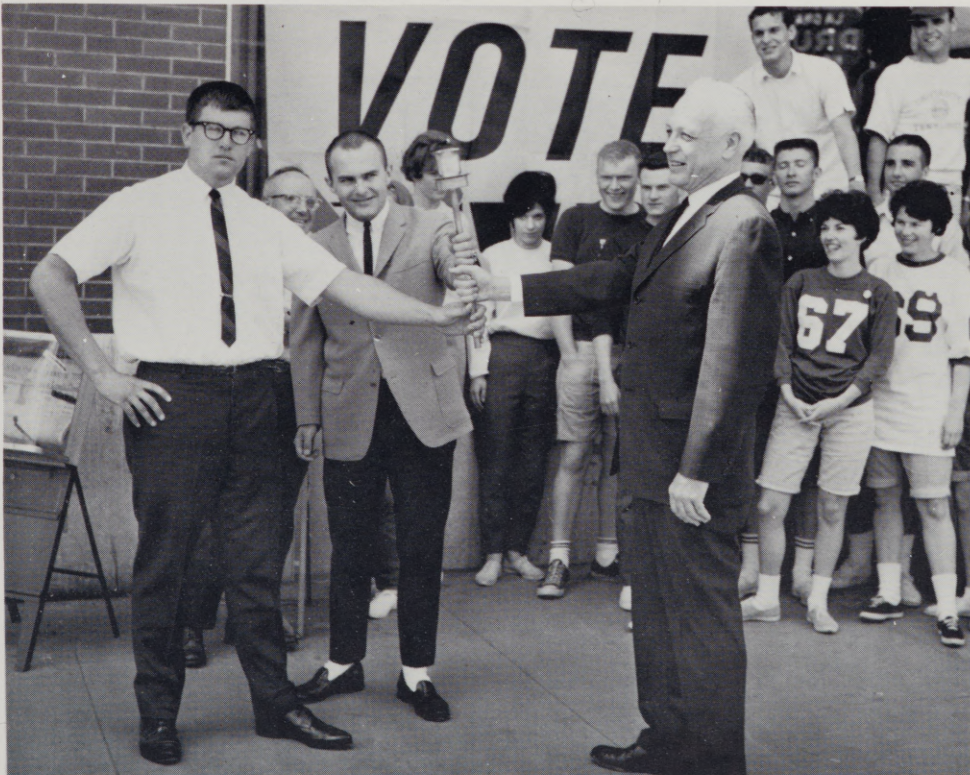

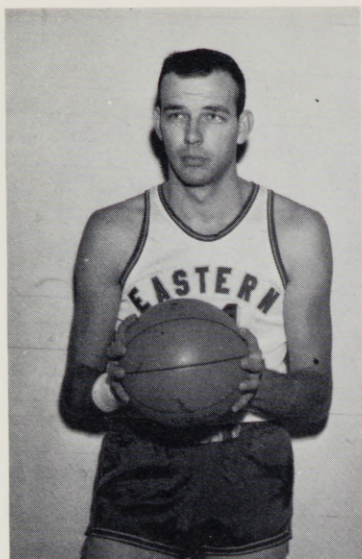

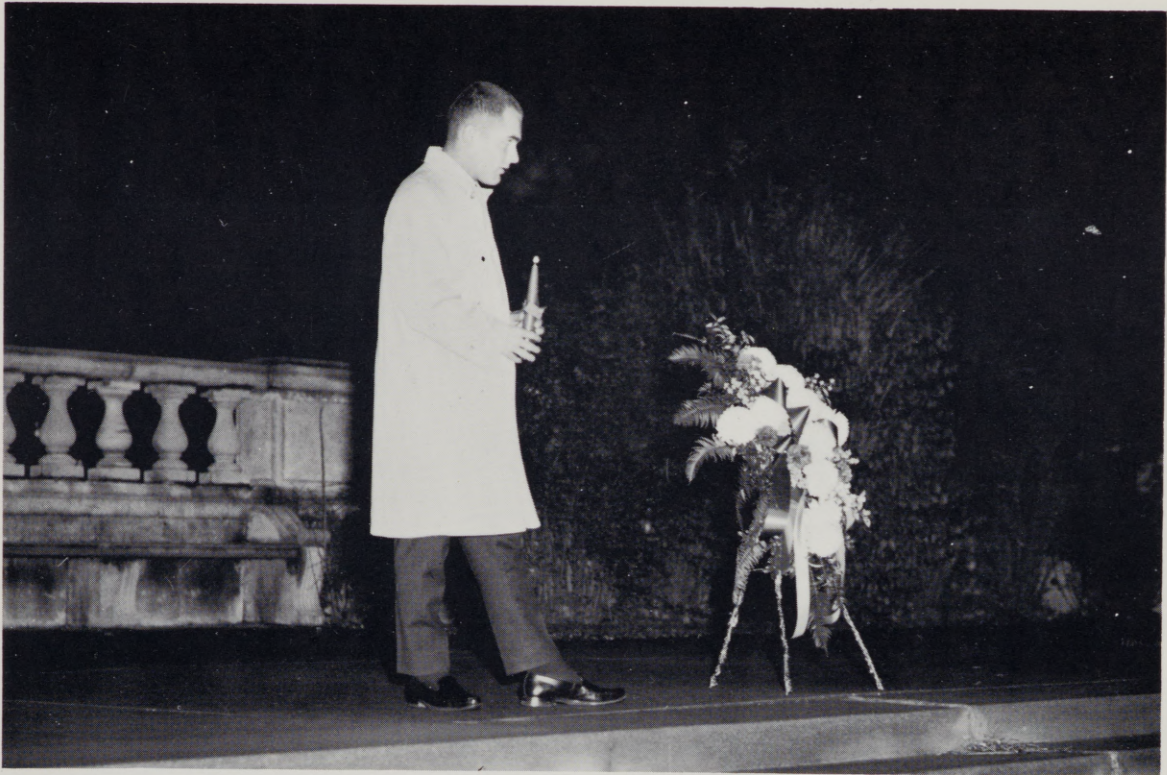


“He Upheld The Faith Of Freedom For All Men”



The assassination of President John F. Kennedy on November 22, 1963 plunged the nation into shock and grief. On Sunday evening, November 24, students from Hunt Hall, Dorion Halls East and West held a solemn service of remembrance for the deceased President and placed a floral wreath at the base of the flagpole.

Speaking at the Thanksgiving Assembly on November 26, Dr. Bennett expressed the feelings of all when he said, “. . . we have been as one with our nation and the peoples of the world in a therapy of sorrow . . . All have been deeply moved.”
