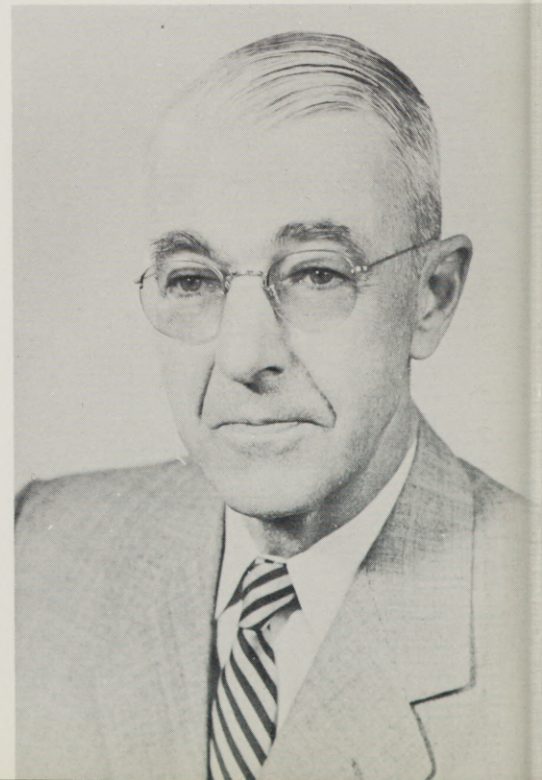

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The State Board of Higher Education at its July meeting dropped the "of Education" from the official name of our college. We have now become EASTERN OREGON COLLEGE.

This change in name gives us no less responsibility for the training of both elementary and secondary teachers. The seemingly simple change in name does, however, emphasize that an extension of privilege to serve also as a regional college has been granted.

The previous actions of the Board giving us broad offerings in pre-professional and semi-professional course work had already indicated a regional responsibility. Even more significant had been the further action of the 1953 Legislature. This action extended to our college the privilege of offering liberal arts work leading to a Bachelor of Science degree in General Studies with majors in the areas of humanities, social science and math-science.

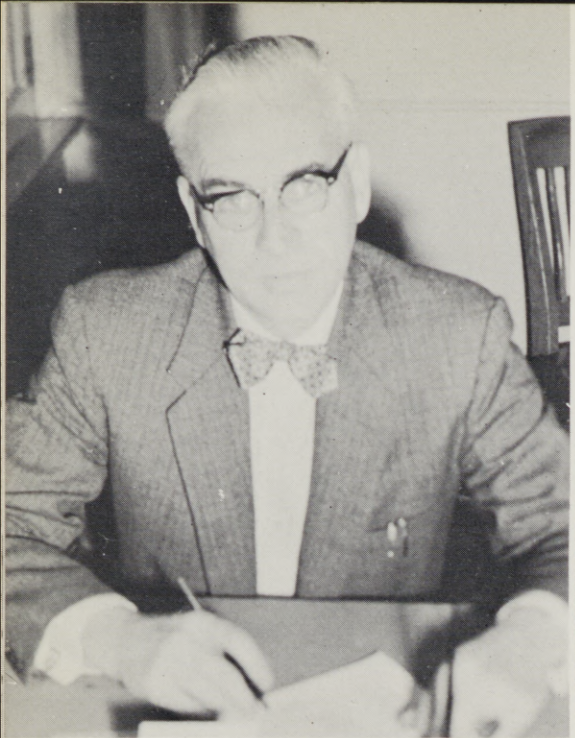

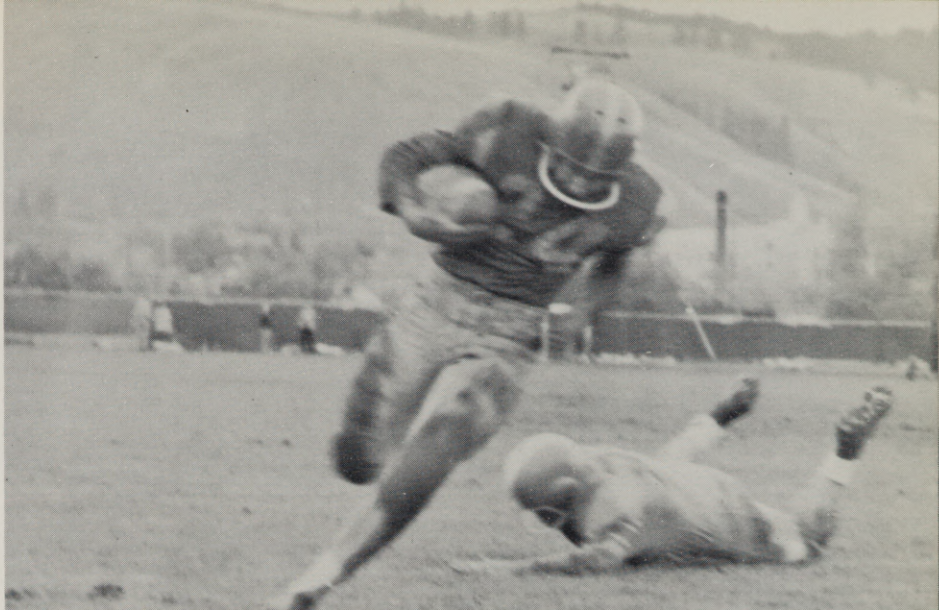
The Mountaineers enjoyed one of their best seasons ever during the 1956 football campaign. Their record was five wins and three losses. Four of the five wins were in conference play, which gave them undisputed first place in the Oregon Collegiate Conference. The three losses came at the hands of Northwest Conference schools.

They started the season with an unimpressive, hard fought seven to six win over a determined Westminster eleven from Salt Lake City, Utah. The next week they traveled to Caldwell for a game with the Coyotes of College of Idaho. The strong Coyotes bumped the Mountaineers hard in this game by winning 40-13. The following Saturday the Blue and Gold took it on the chin again. This time the Whitman Missionaries were the victorious crew, winning 32-31. Saturday, October the sixth, Oregon College from Monmouth invaded La Grade for the Mountaineer's first conference game. The Mounties were not to be stopped on this one. They won 20-12. The thirteenth of October was homecoming at E.O.C., and Oregon Tech found out in a hurry that the Mountaineers weren't going to lose this one; score E.O.C. 25, O.T.I. 18. E.O.C. went out of their conference the next week to play Pacific University at Forest Grove. The game was played on a muddy field, and the Mountaineers couldn't get their offense working. They lost 13-7. The following two Saturday afternoons were important ones for the Mounties, but they took them in stride.

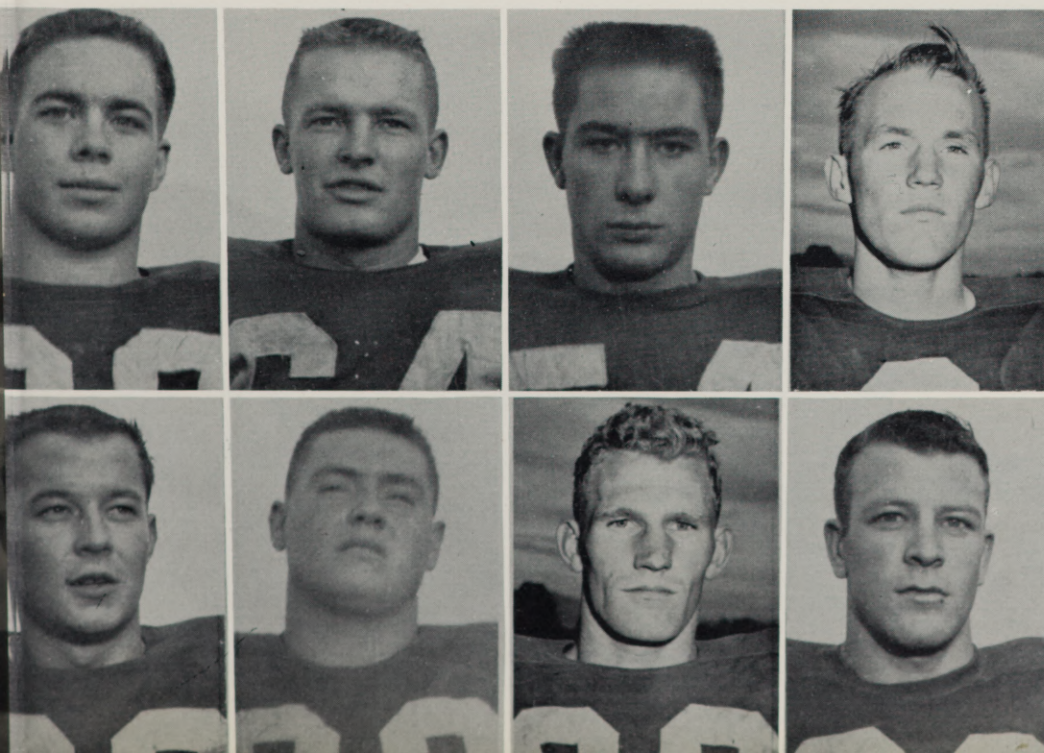
Daggett (22) breaks through the middle for yardage. Earl Smith (80).

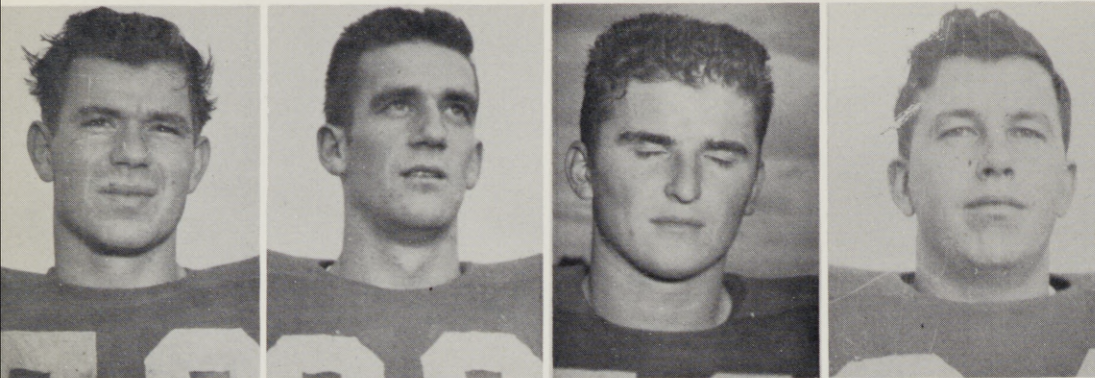


Ziegenhagen scampers around the End against O.T.I.

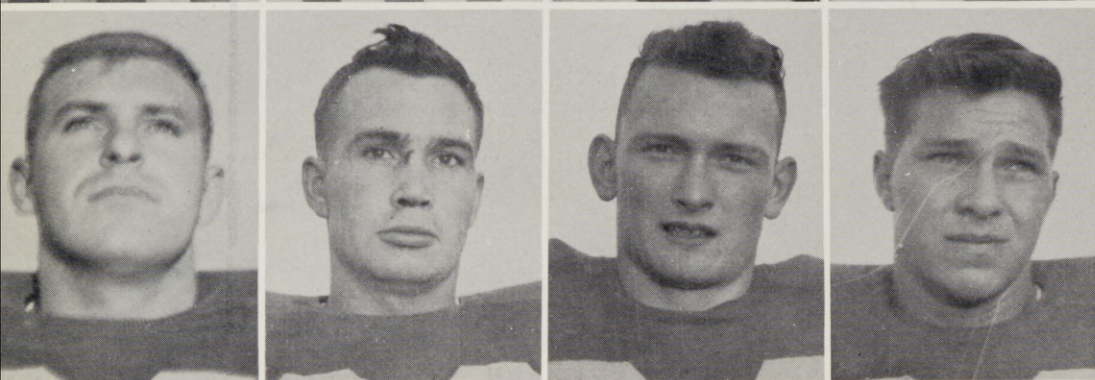

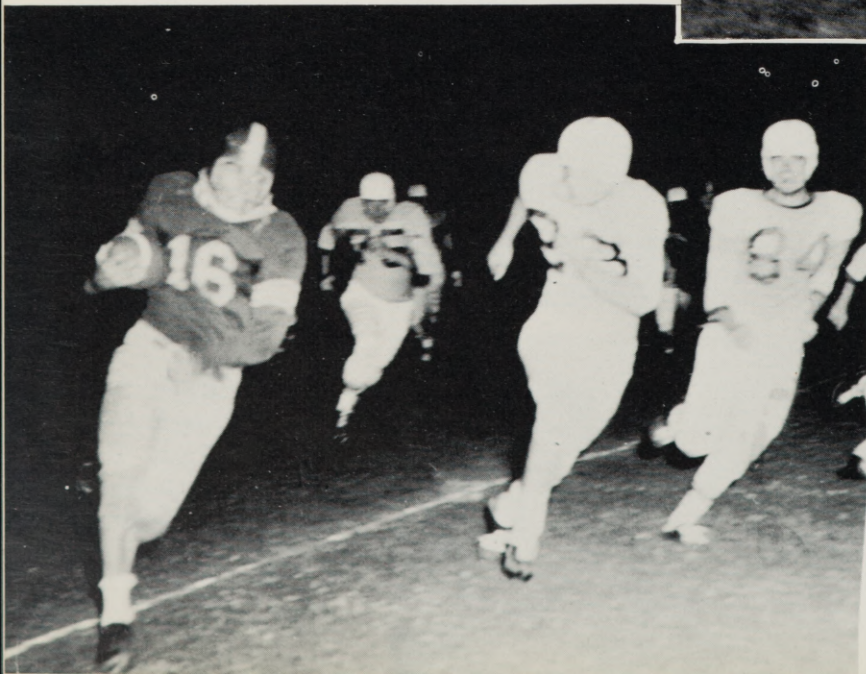

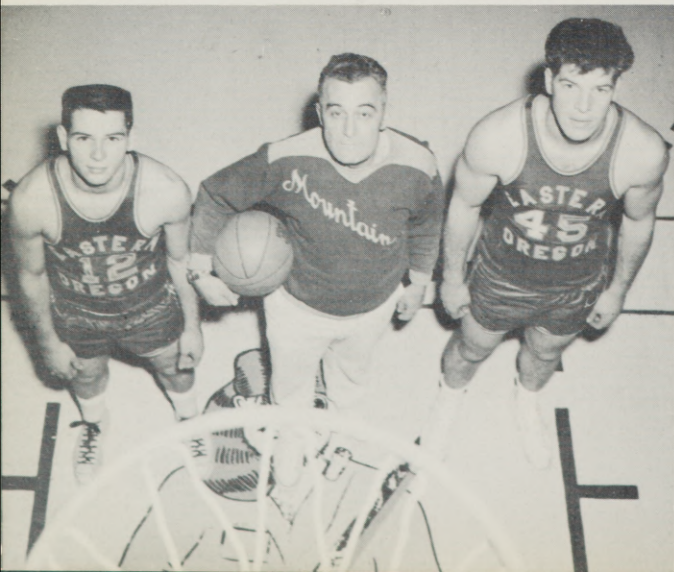

## BASKETBALL 1957

## THE SEASON

"We'll be playing to stay out of the cellar." Those were the words of Coach E. Robert "Bob" Quinn in his 28th year as EOC basketball mentor, as the Mountaineers began the 1956-57 season.

And the 10-16 record compiled by EOC is a good one considering the fact that no regulars returned from the previous season — and only two lettermen. The team finished third in the Oregon Collegiate Conference with a 7-9 record. EOC did well at home, winning seven of the 12 contests before the local crowds.

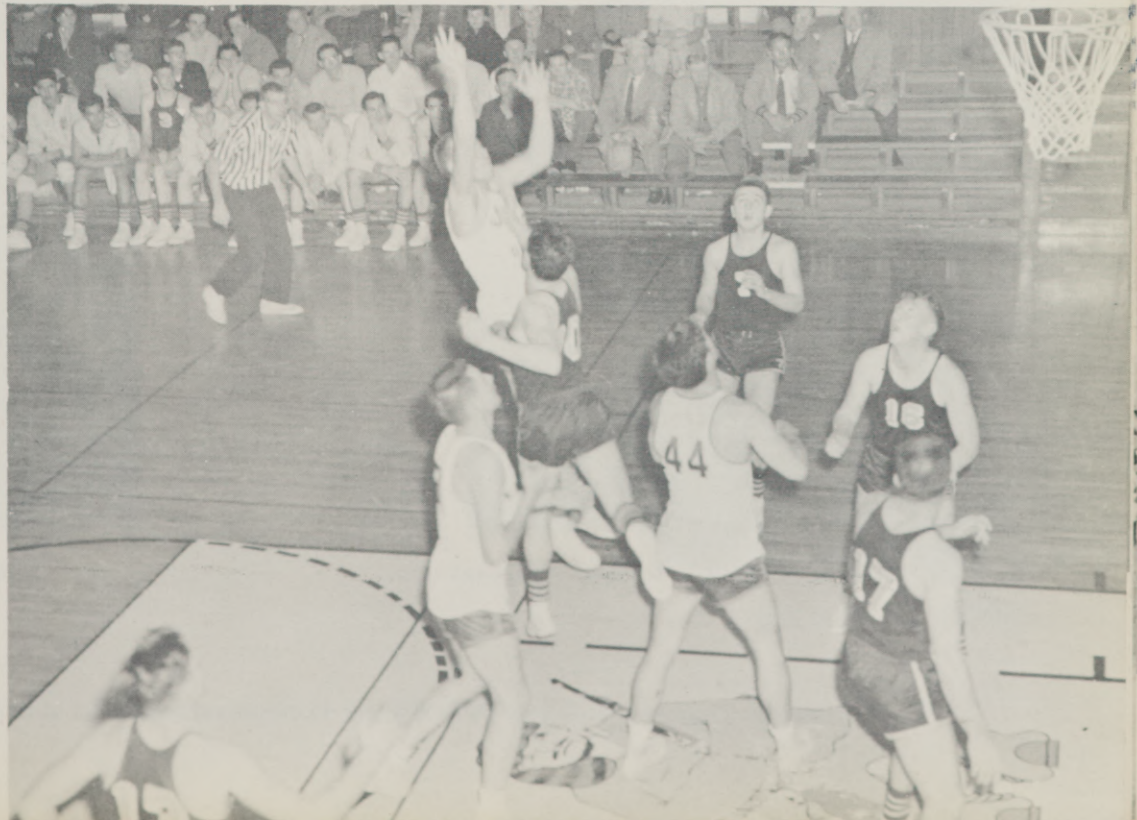
Larry Howard, sophomore letterman from last year's squad, topped all scorers with a 368 point total on 134 field goals and 100 free throws. Other totals for the first quintet at season's close show Earle Smith with 275, Jerrold Baxter with 229, Dick Quinn with 176, and Ron Paulson and Weldon Lewis competing in the last four games, 25 and 20 points respectively.

Jerrold Baxter, Union Sophomore, set new EOC records in rebounding, with 209 from defensive boards to make a record total of 340. Jerry, who averaged a record 13.1 rebounds per game, also collected 131 while on offence.

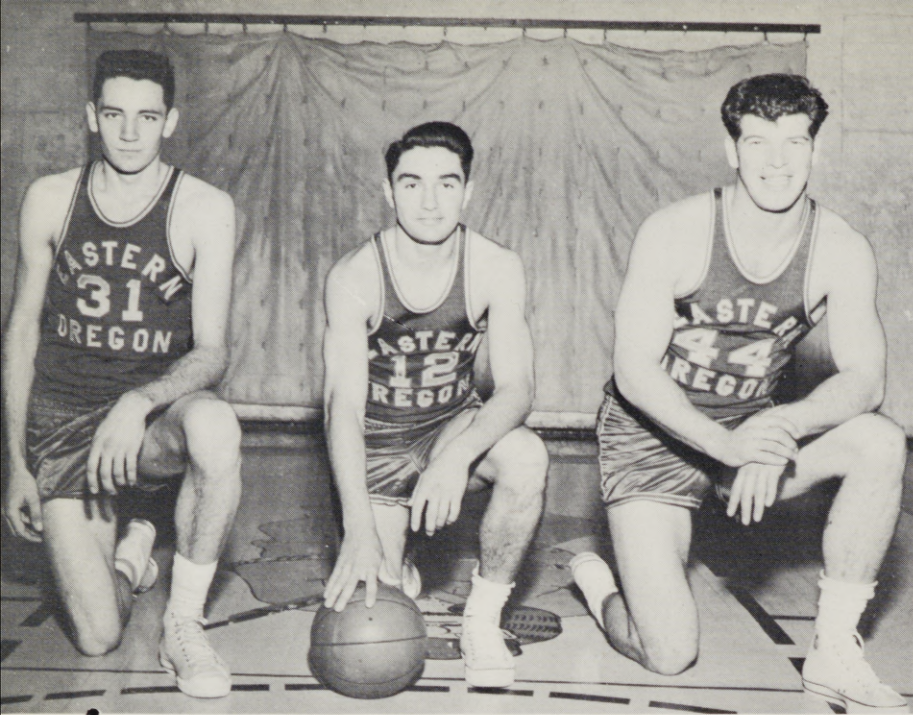

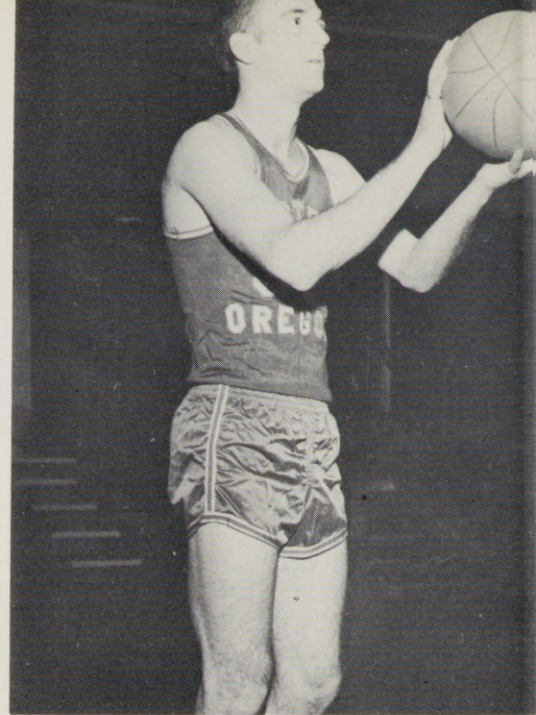
