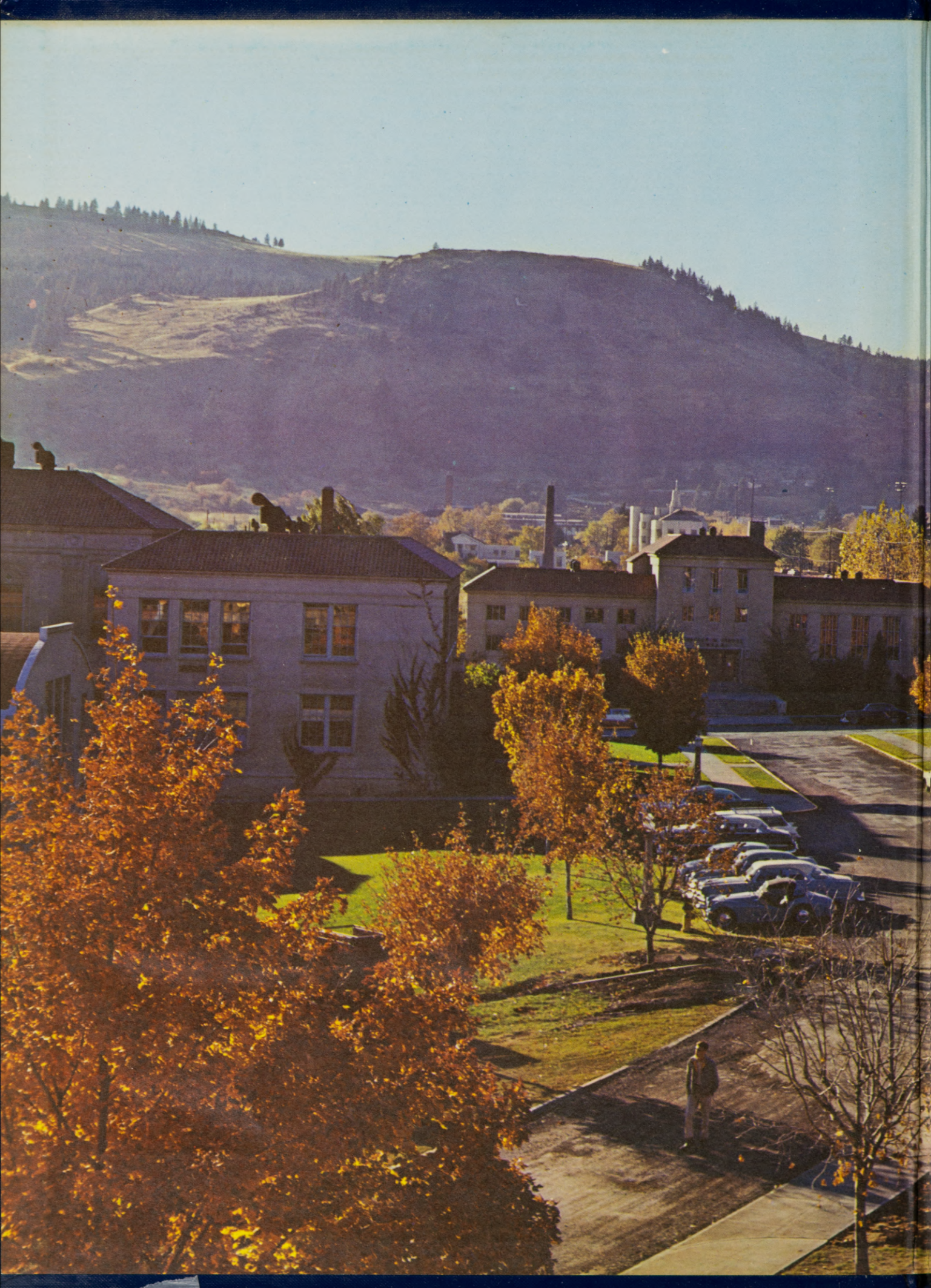

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This year Eastern Oregon College has experienced a major student growth. Our fall term enrollment reached 1,070 students while the winter term enrollment continued to exceed 1,000 students.

By the fall of 1962 a new unit at the men's dormitory will be available for use. Also, by the fall of 1962 sixteen additional married student housing units will be initially occupied. By the fall of 1963 a new unit will be available at the women's dormitory. This addition will double the housing capacity of Dorion Hall.

Our new venture in lower division Agriculture has been quite successful. This program became available to us by our contractual arrangement with Oregon State University to use two of their highly trained agriculturists. These persons instruct our courses in soils and animal science.

We are currently working on preliminary plans for a new science building and an addition to the library. These projects will be proposed to the 1963 Legislature and will require its approval. If the necessary appropriation is approved for them, we will hope to have both units in use by the fall of 1964 or 1965.

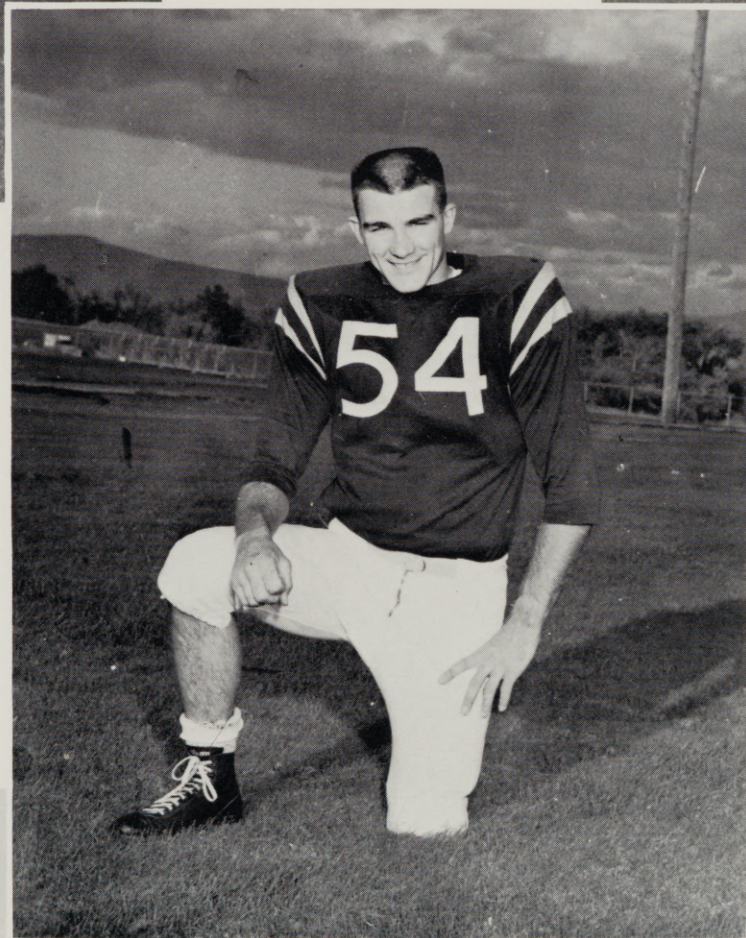
RON ROBINSON

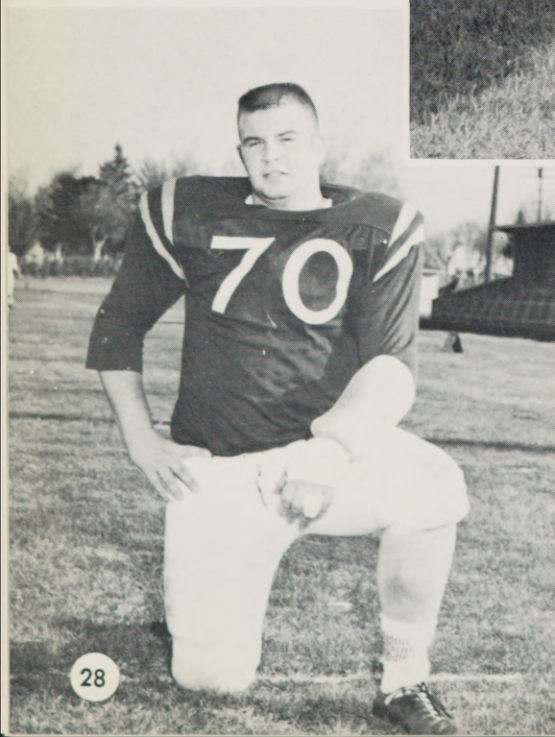
STEPHEN STRAUGHAN

Herb played the halfback position this year for the Mounties coming from Redmon where he was active in high school sports.



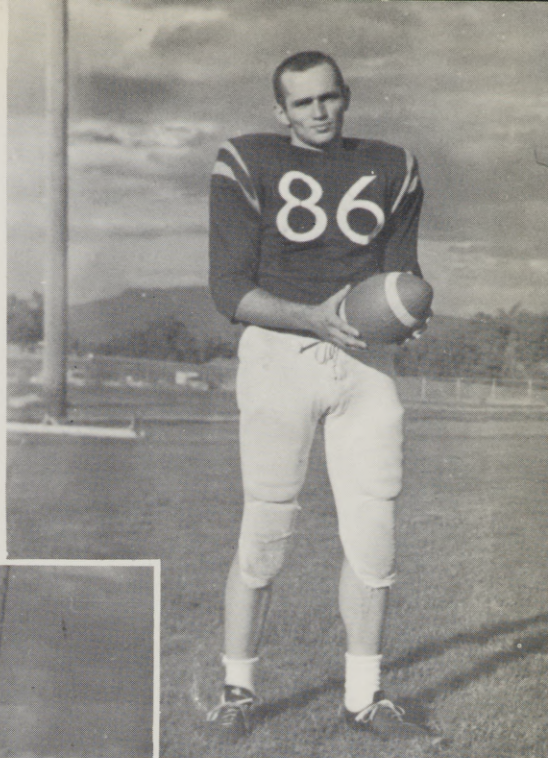
ROBERT SALTER

Richard was the only returning guard for the Mounties this year. Dick will be a senior next year. He was also active in high school sports earning letters in football, basketball, and track.

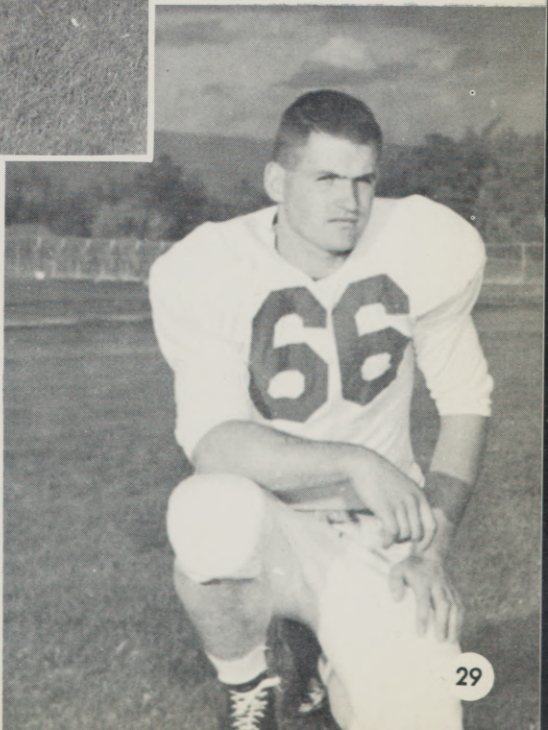
KEIPPPIE MAY

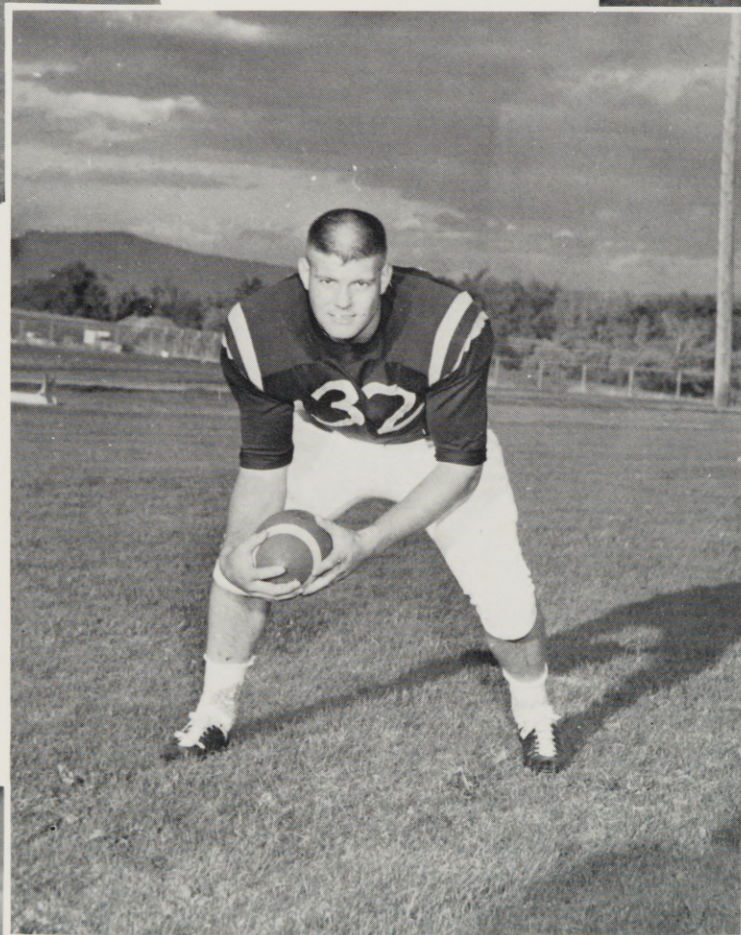
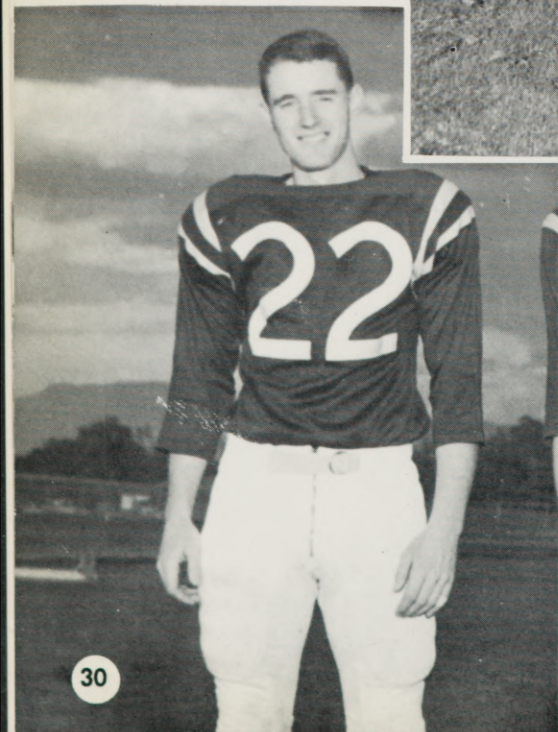


DENNIS OLIVER

FRED SAYRE

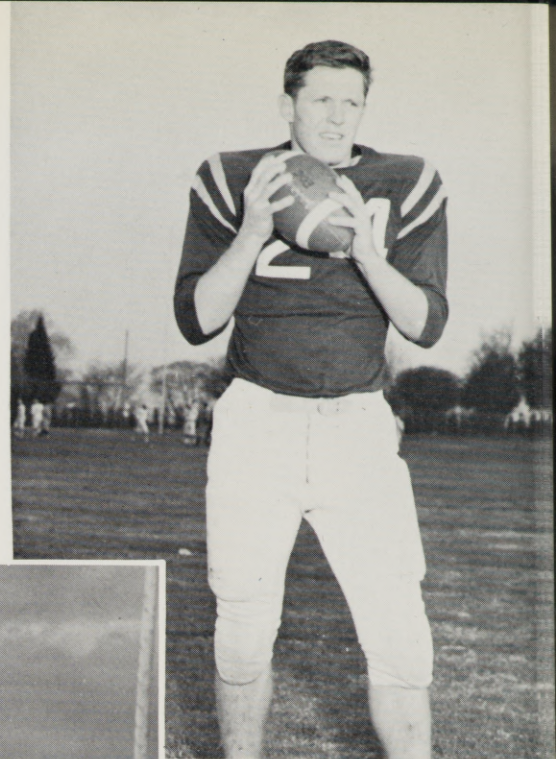

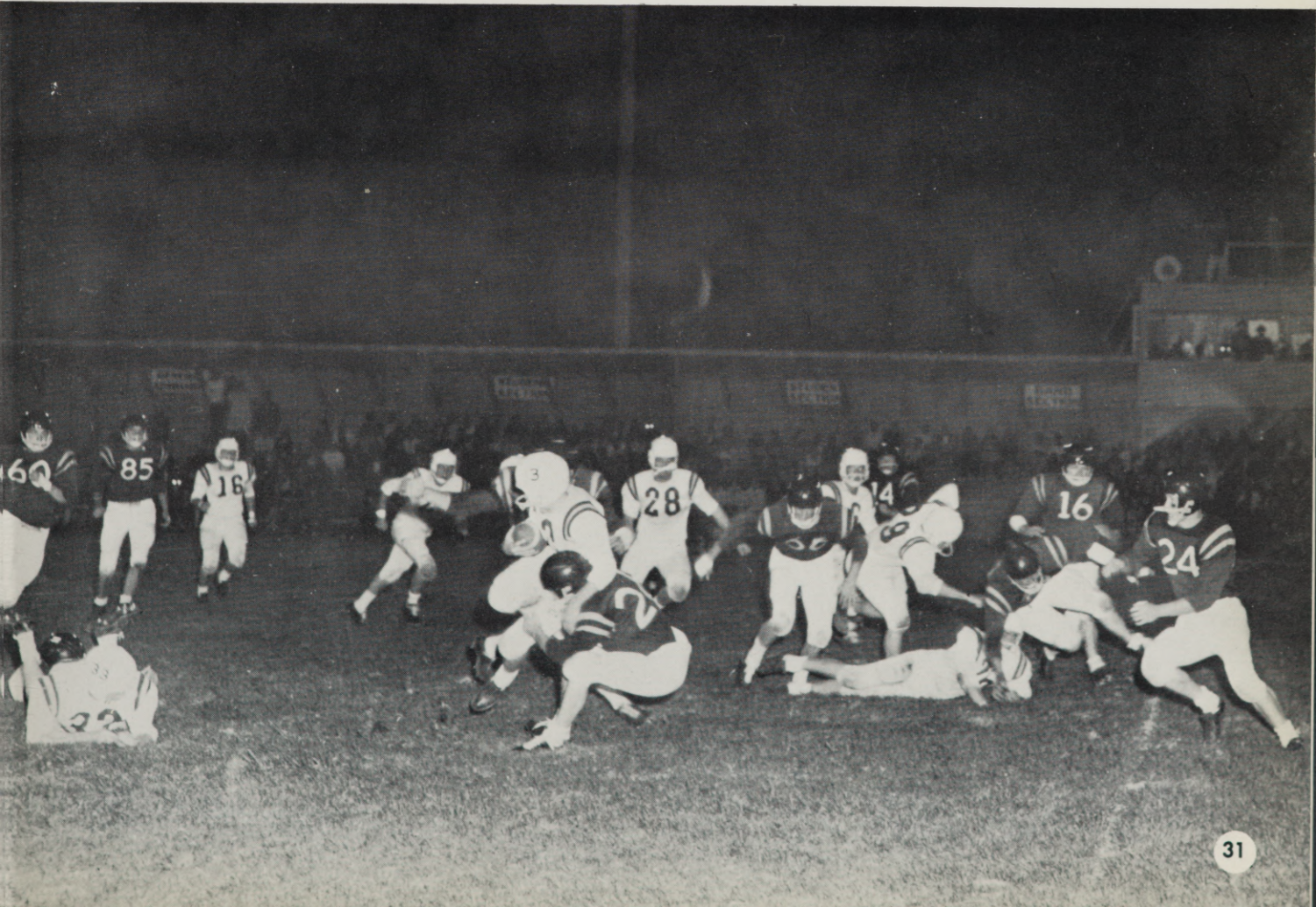
Bob played the quarterback position and was a transfer from Boise Junior College where he played football for two years. Coming from Vale, Oregon. Bob was also very active in high school sports.

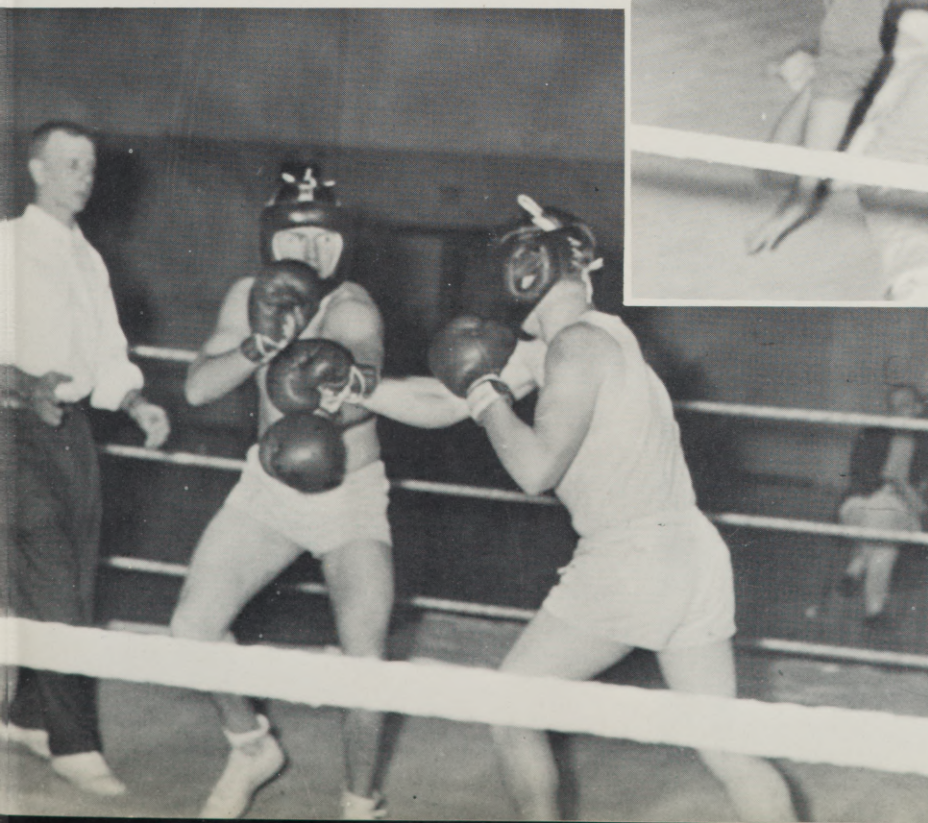
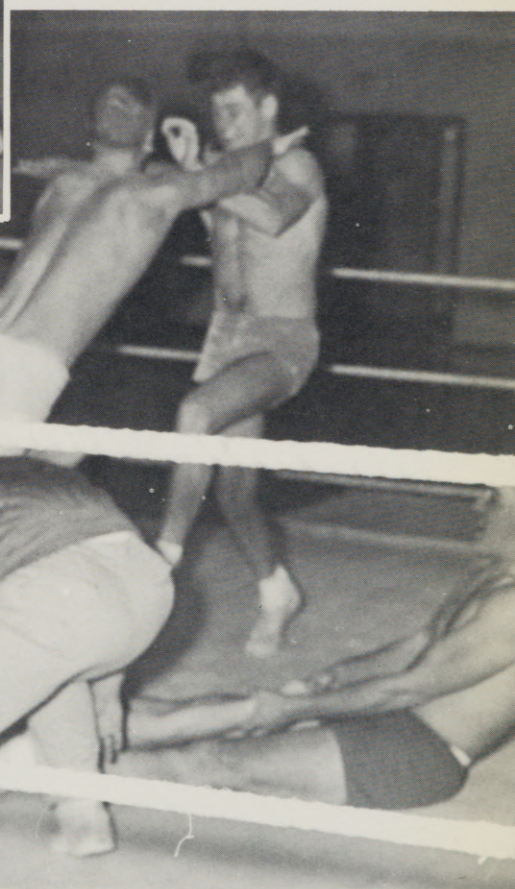
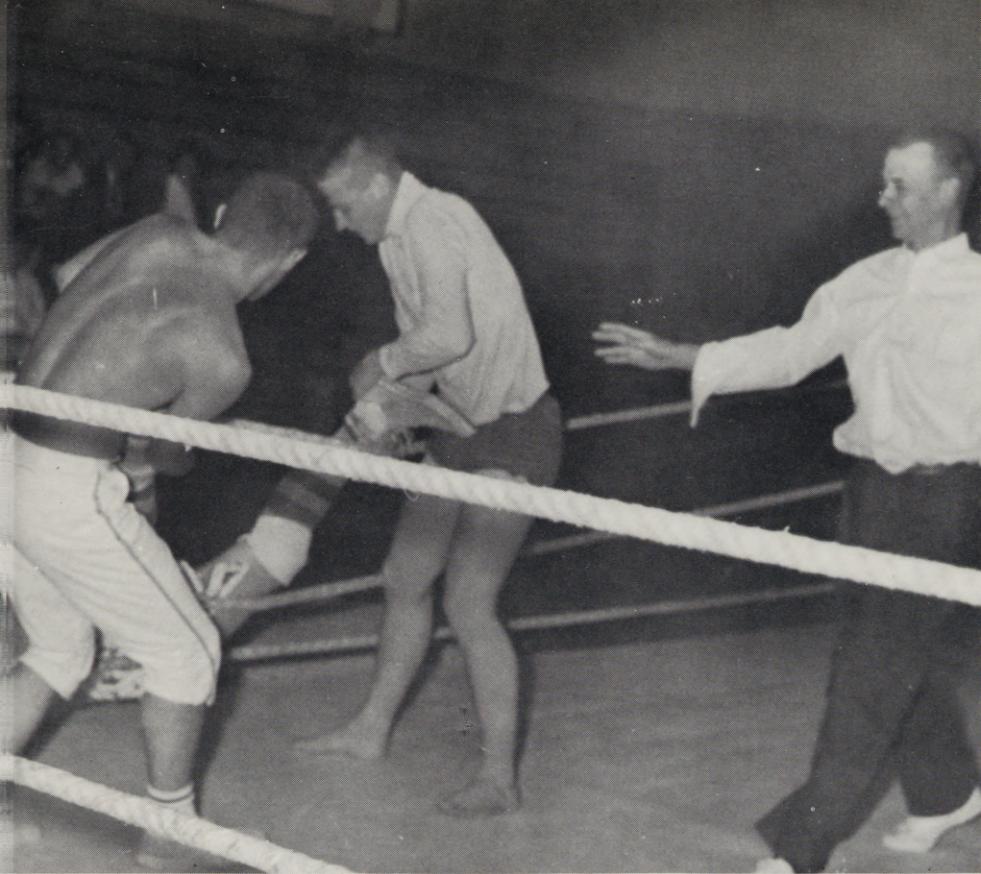


Most Valuable Player

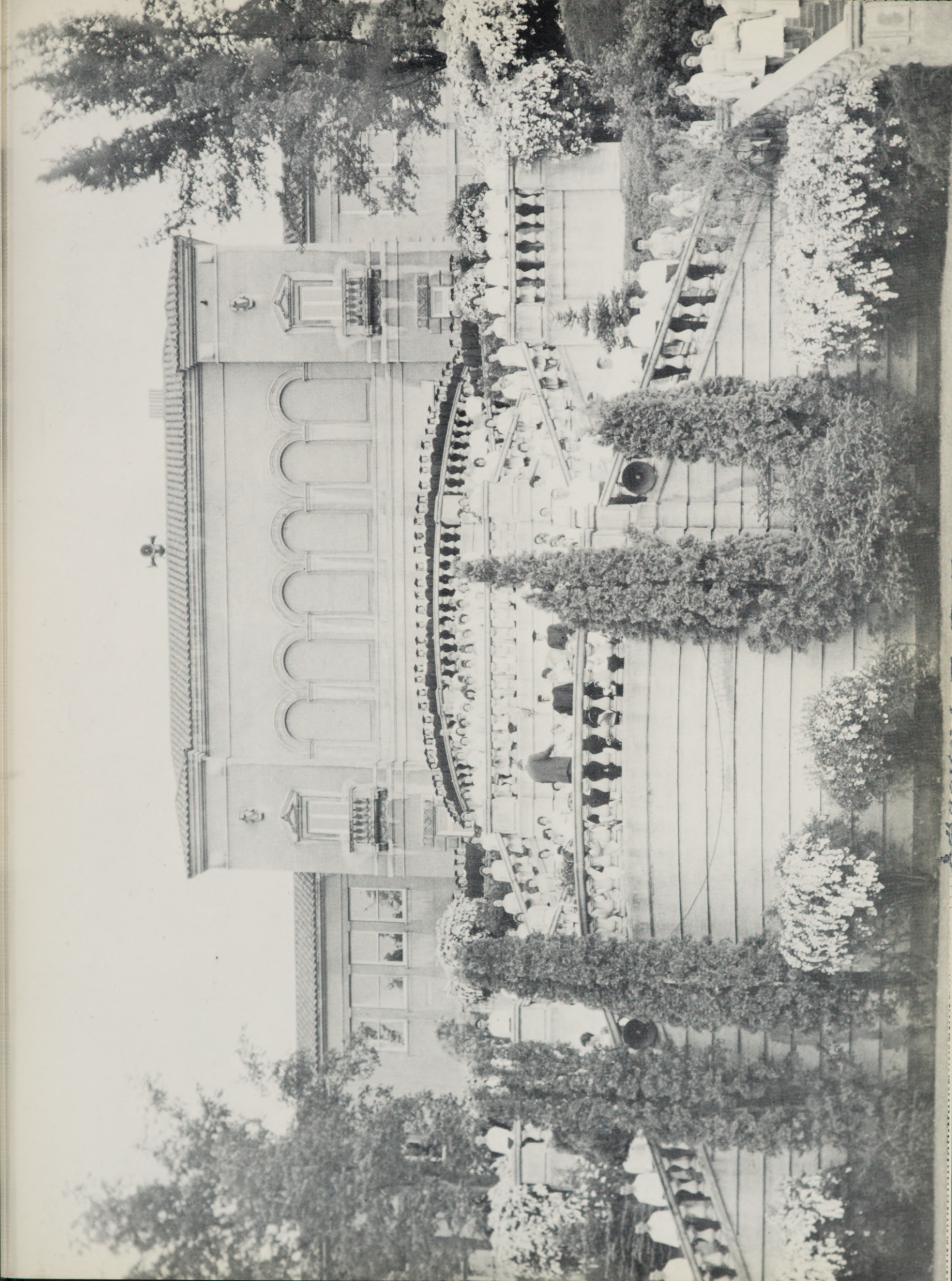

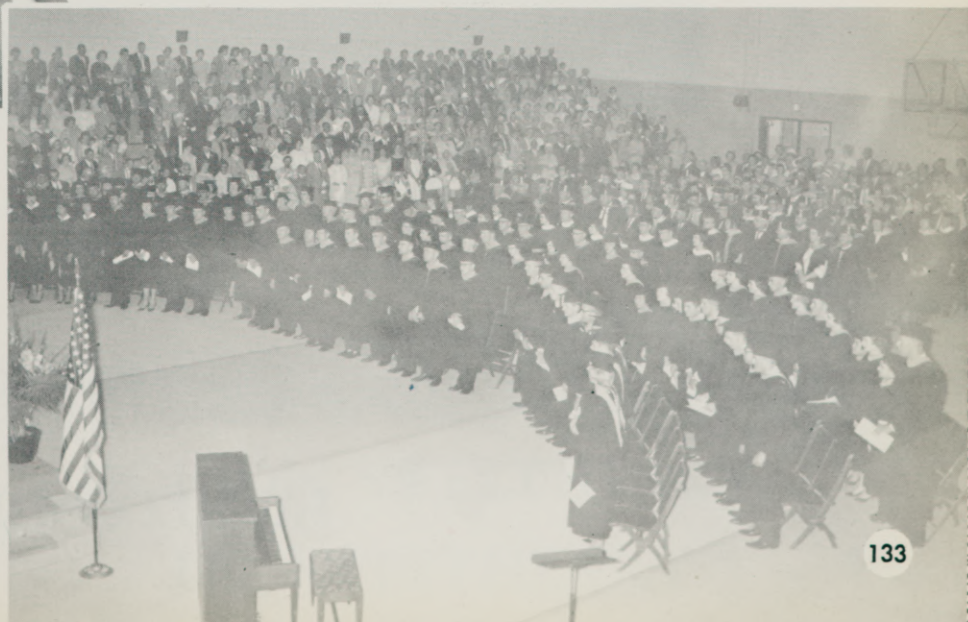
