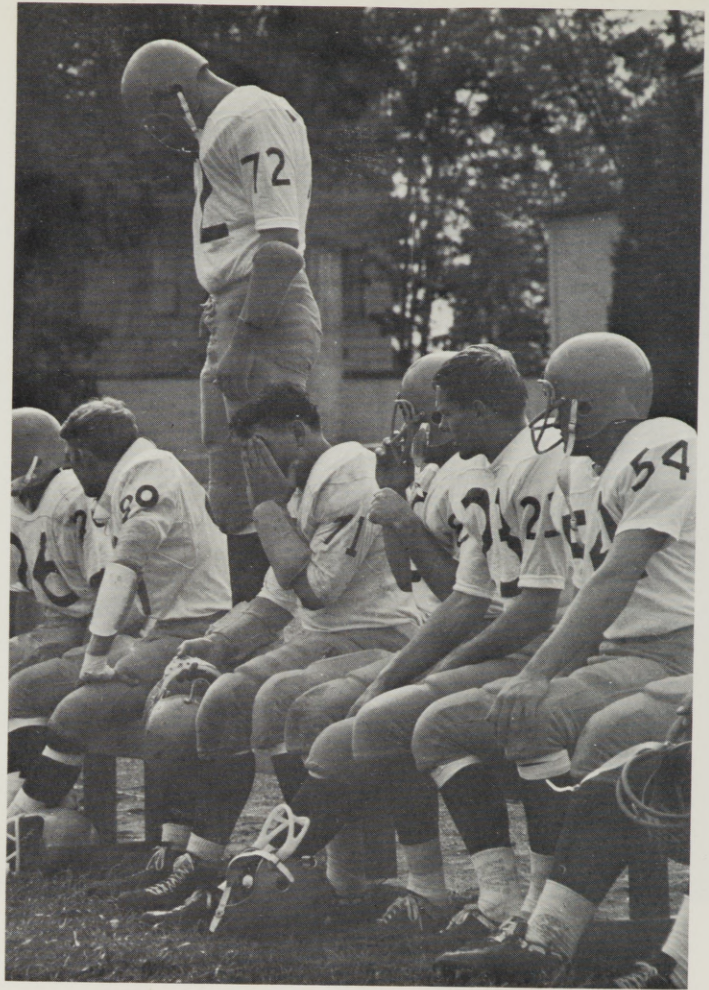

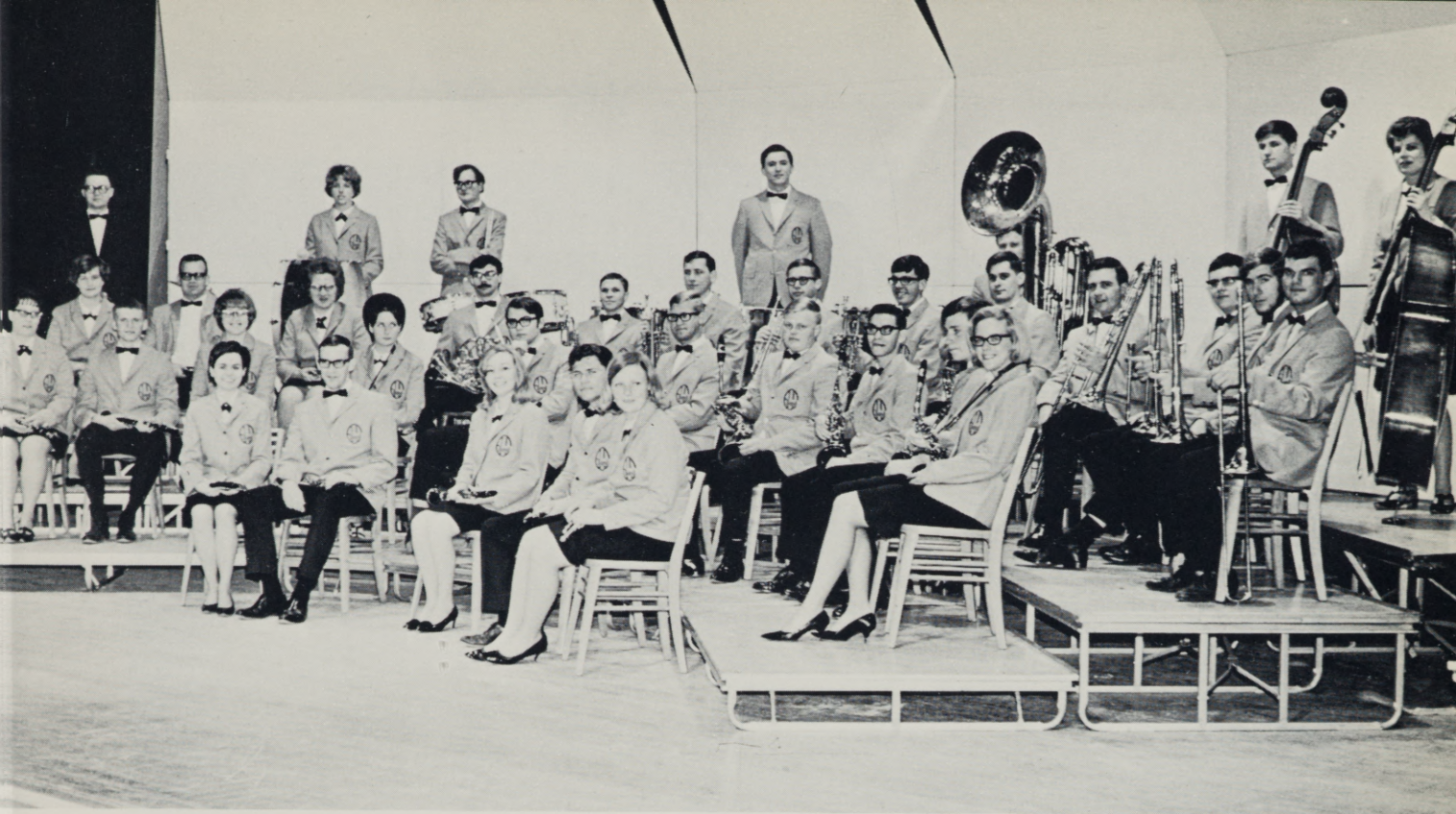
R's Poetica

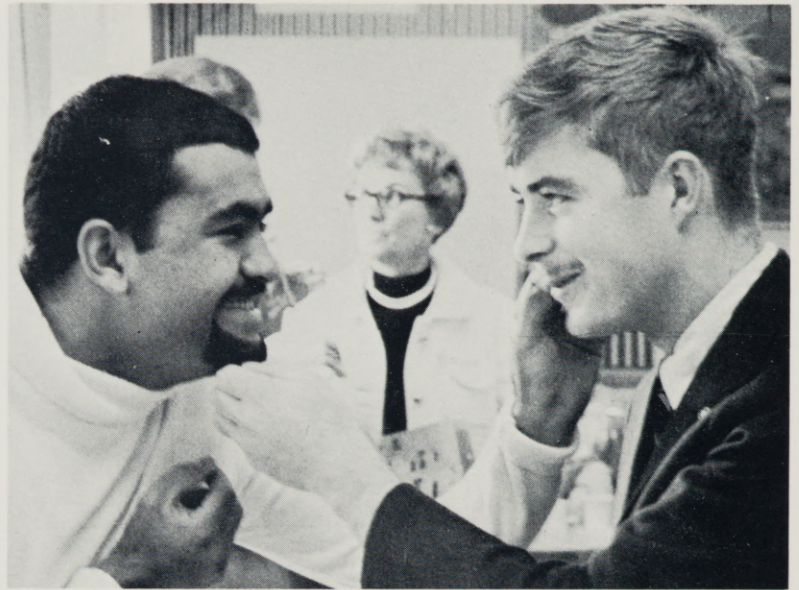

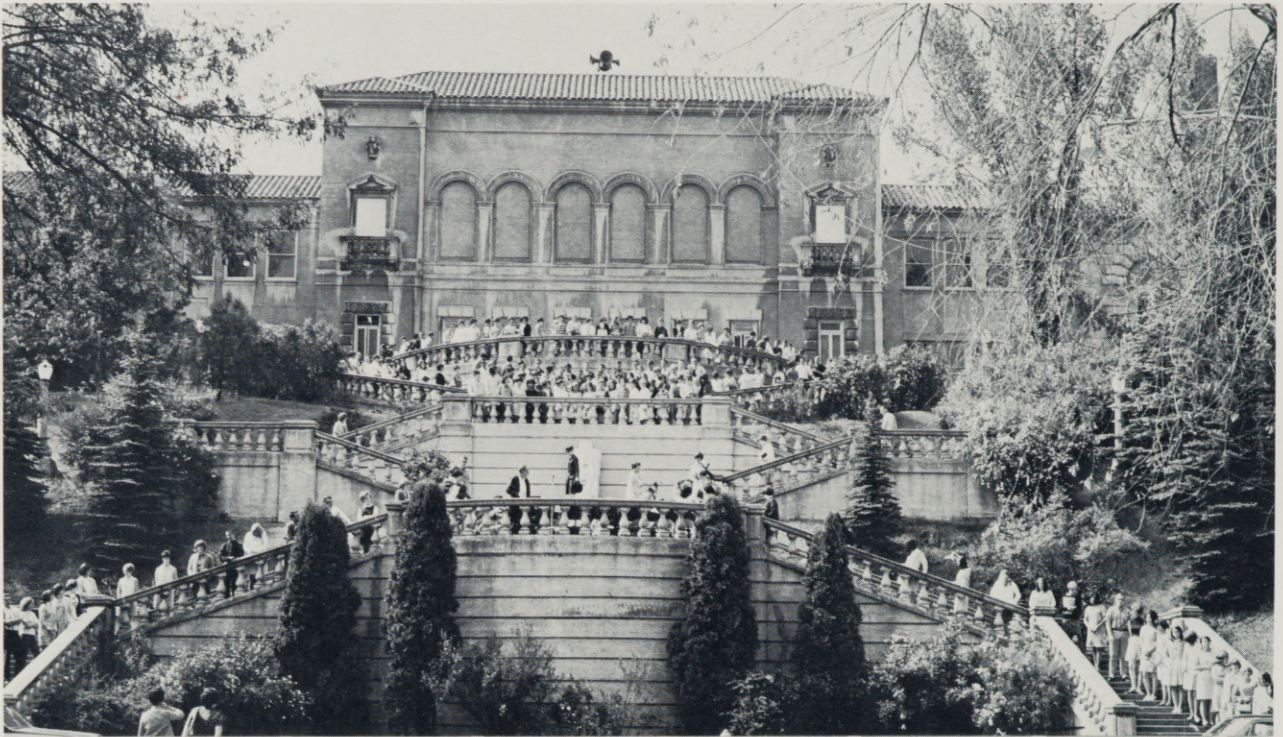

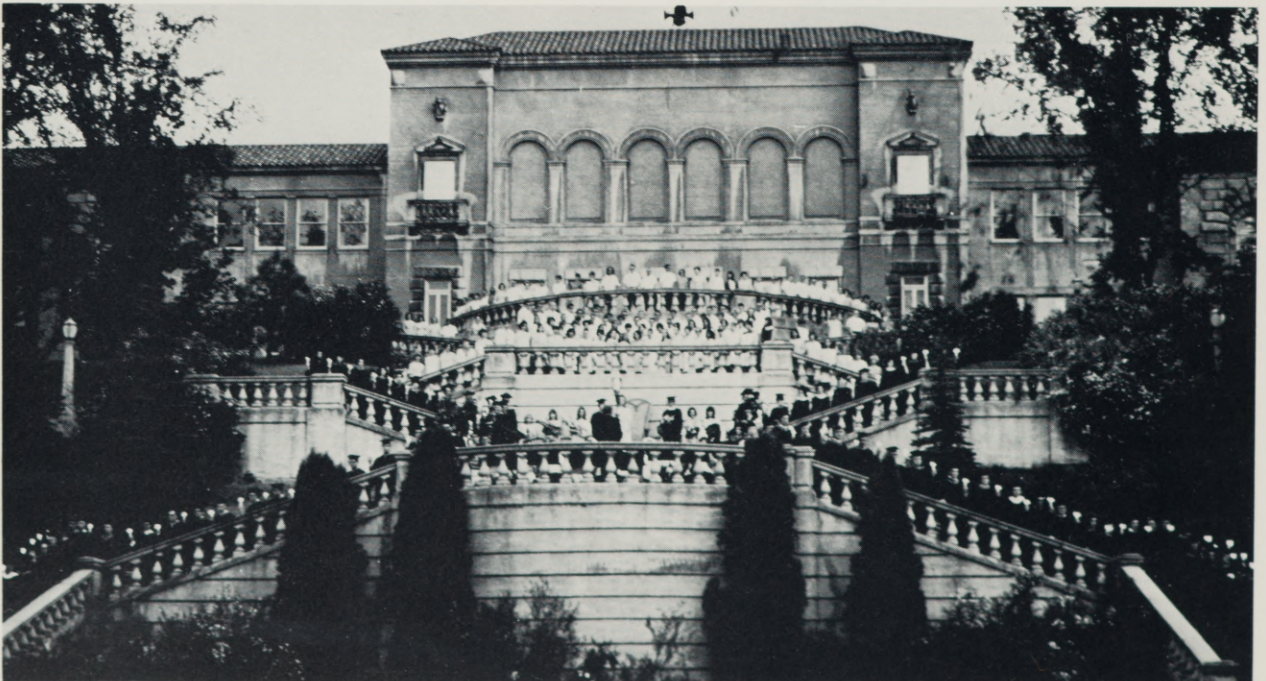

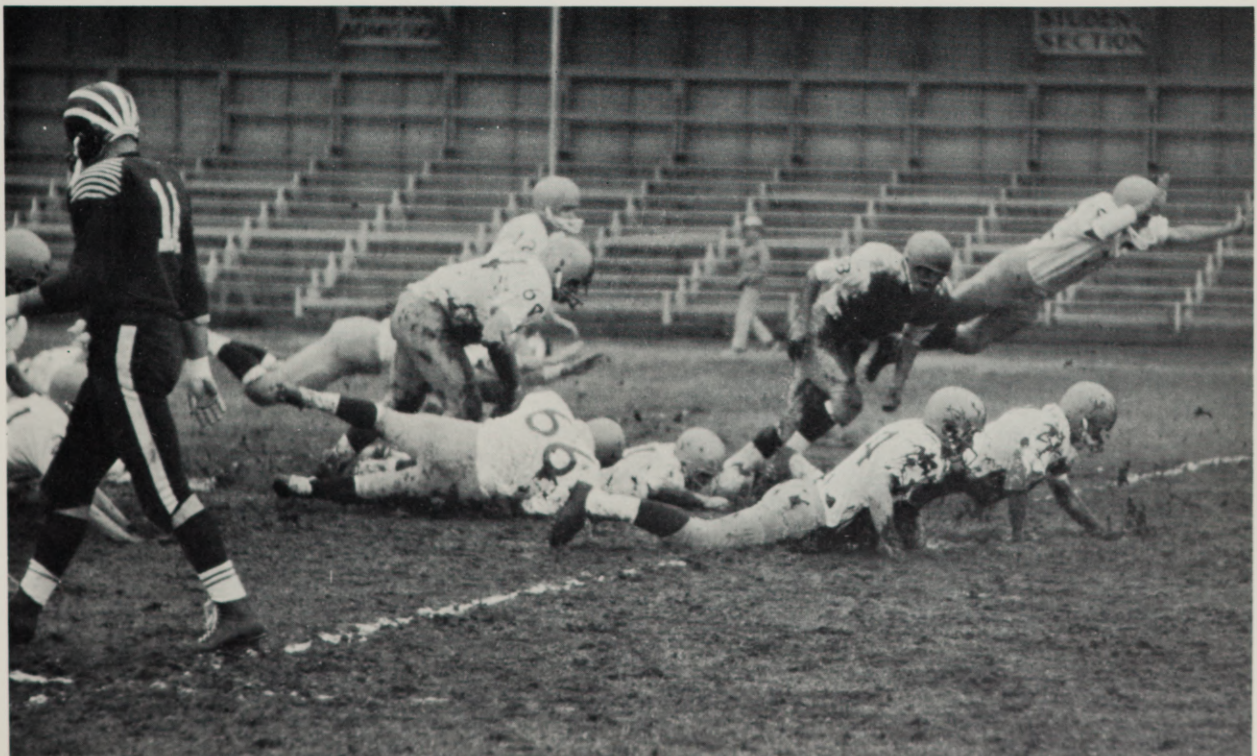

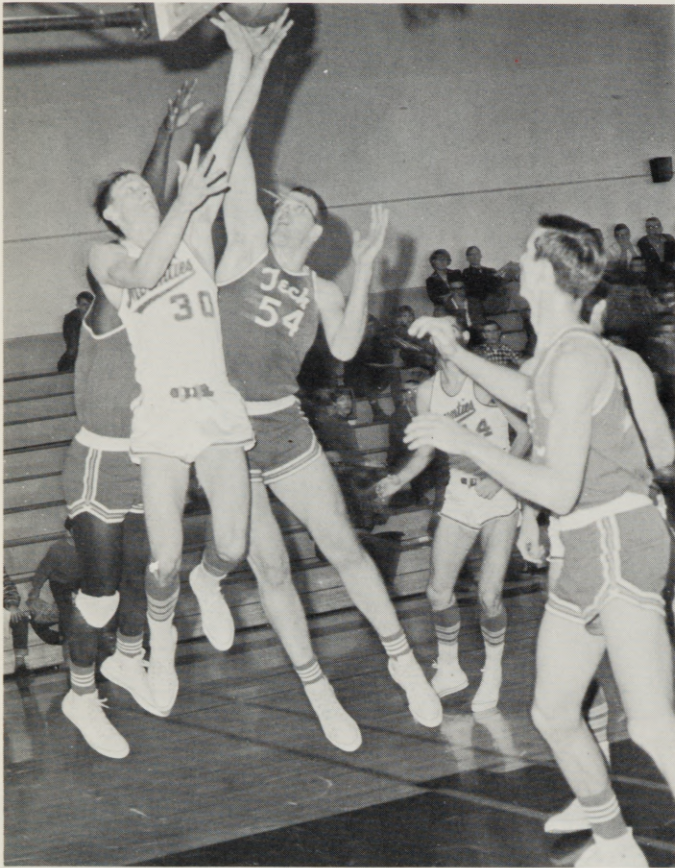

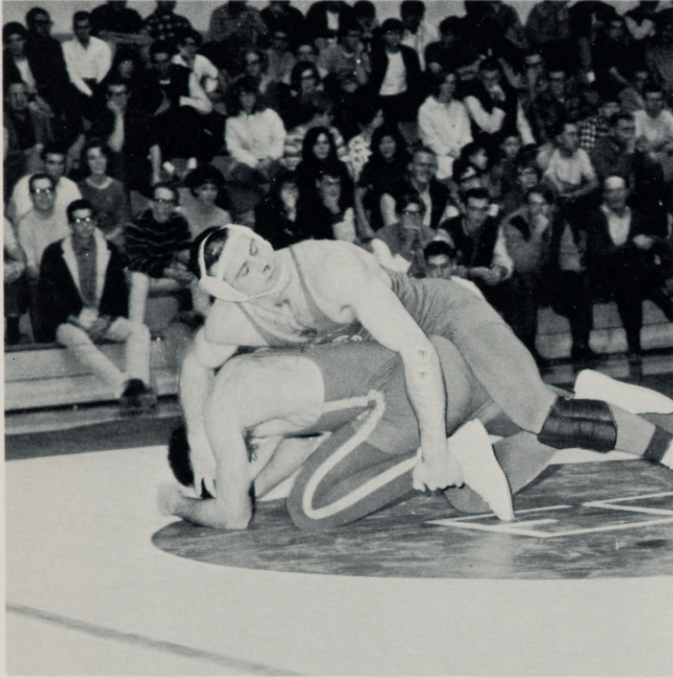

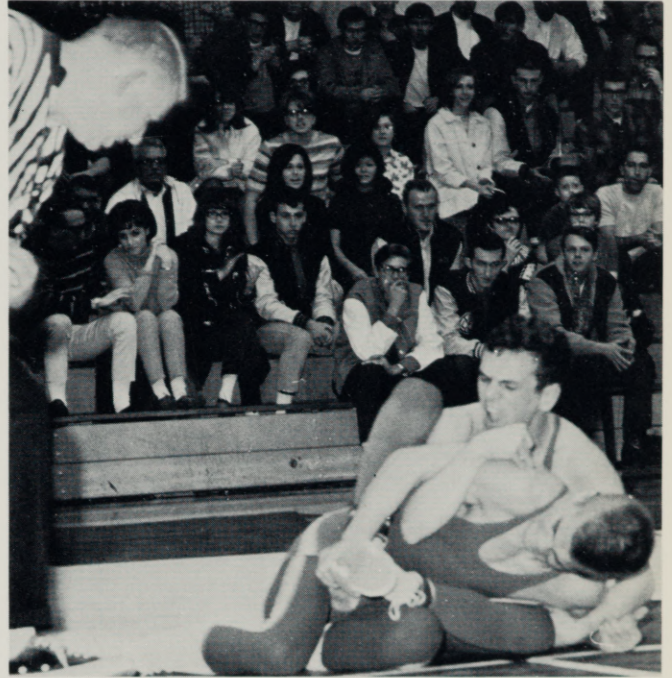

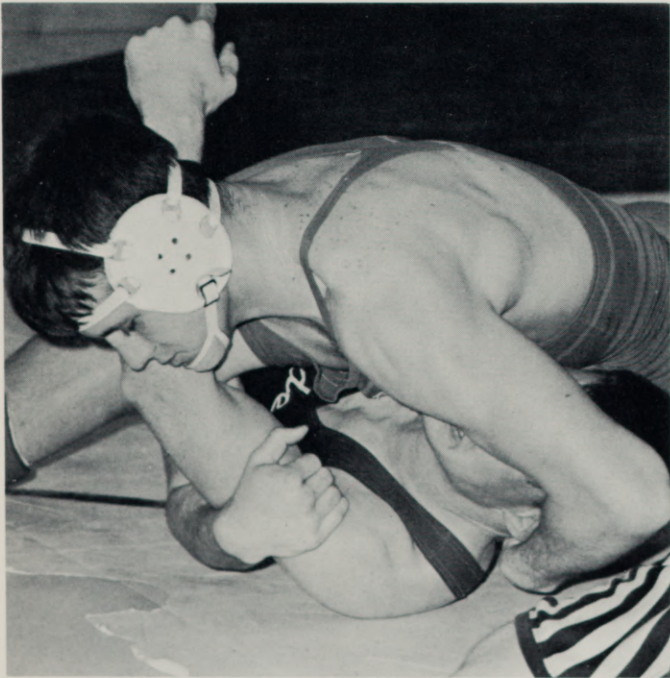

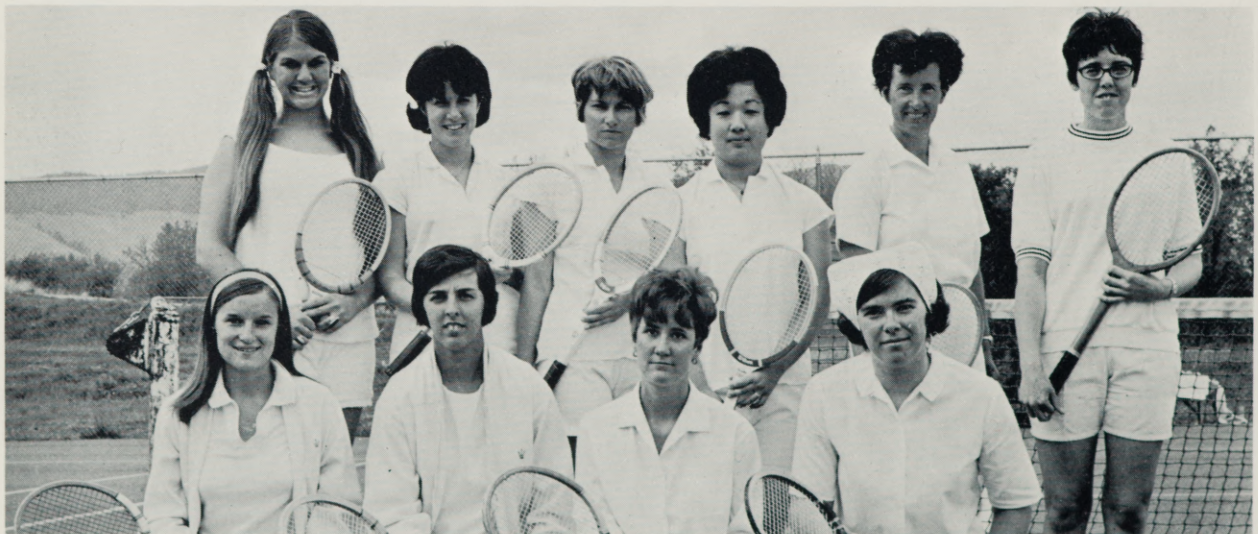
