OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT

Eastern Oregon College of Education is now contemplating appropriate recognition of its Twenty-Fifth Anniversary. The year 1953-54 will mark that important milestone. As we approach this anniversary, we are happy to review our progress and to anticipate the future.

In these first 24 years, Eastern Oregon College has grown from a normal school to a teachers college. It has grown from a school with a two-year training program to a school with a four-year program. The Master of Science Degree in Elementary Education has been added to our offering. Originally but one building served the campus. We now have seven buildings. Our staff has increased year by year until at present we have a faculty of 44 members. Our student body has shown a like growth and this year approached an enrollment of 500 students.

The outlook for the future is also encouraging. On January 5 of this year, the State Board of Higher Education authorized Eastern Oregon College of Education to initiate a program in the fall of 1954 that will expand our offerings to include, in addition to elementary teacher training, a secondary teacher training program. This Board action promises growth in the breadth and depth of our offering. It presages growth in staff and student body. Such growth will require additional physical facilities in order that we may more adequately care for these new responsibilities. Additional dormitory space is presently contemplated and other building needs are under consideration.

Surely the first 25 years will complete the record of a fine chapter in the history of Eastern Oregon College of Education. The prospects for the future can be even brighter. These prospects will be ours to explore. This new chapter will be ours to write. As students, alumni, and staff, we accept its challenge. To this task we dedicate ourselves.

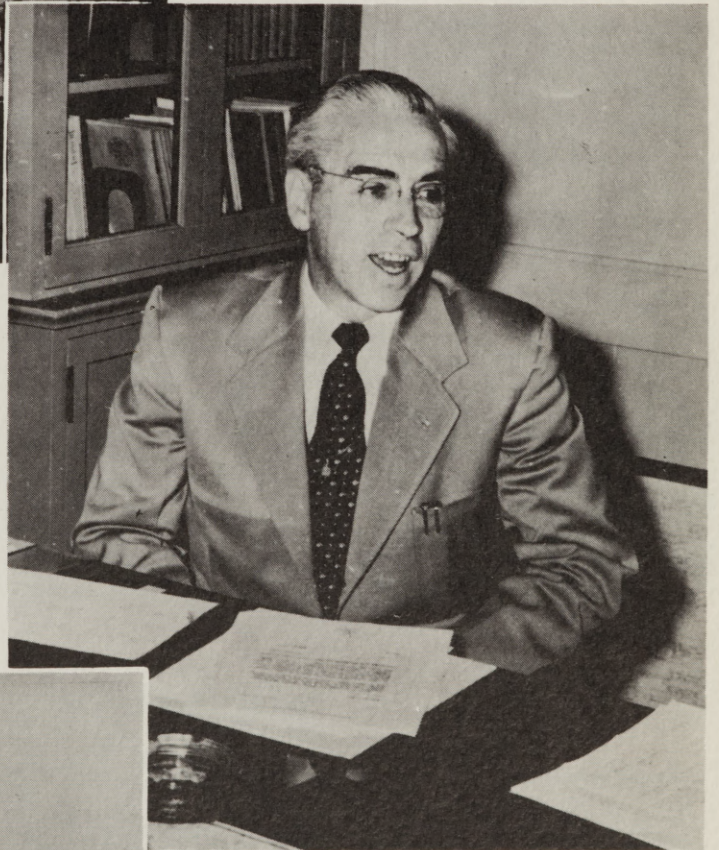

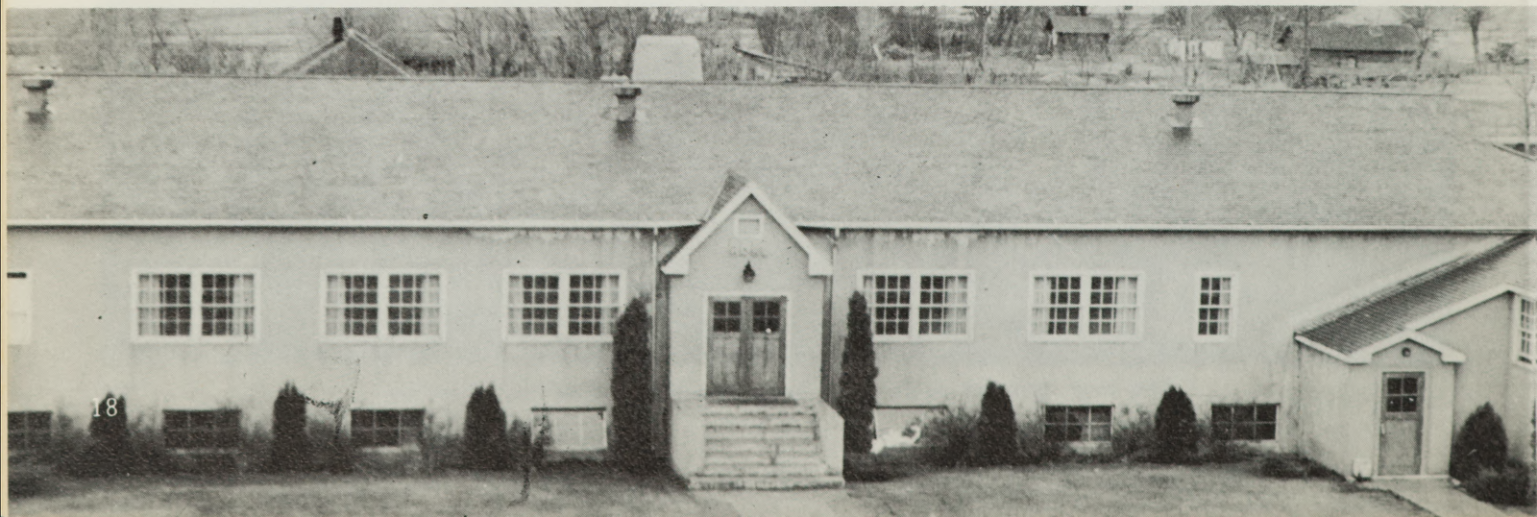
# Fifth Year Students

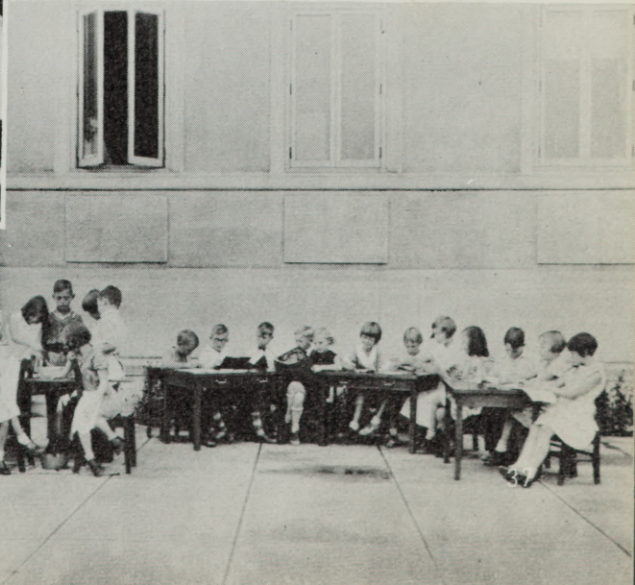

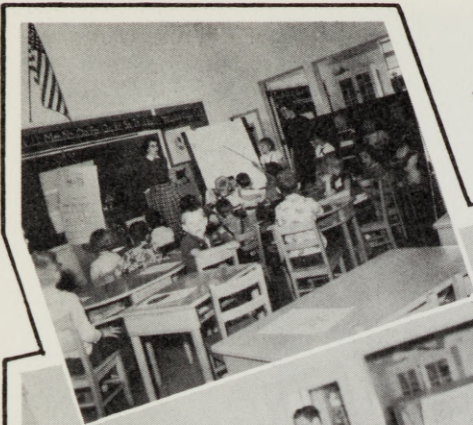
