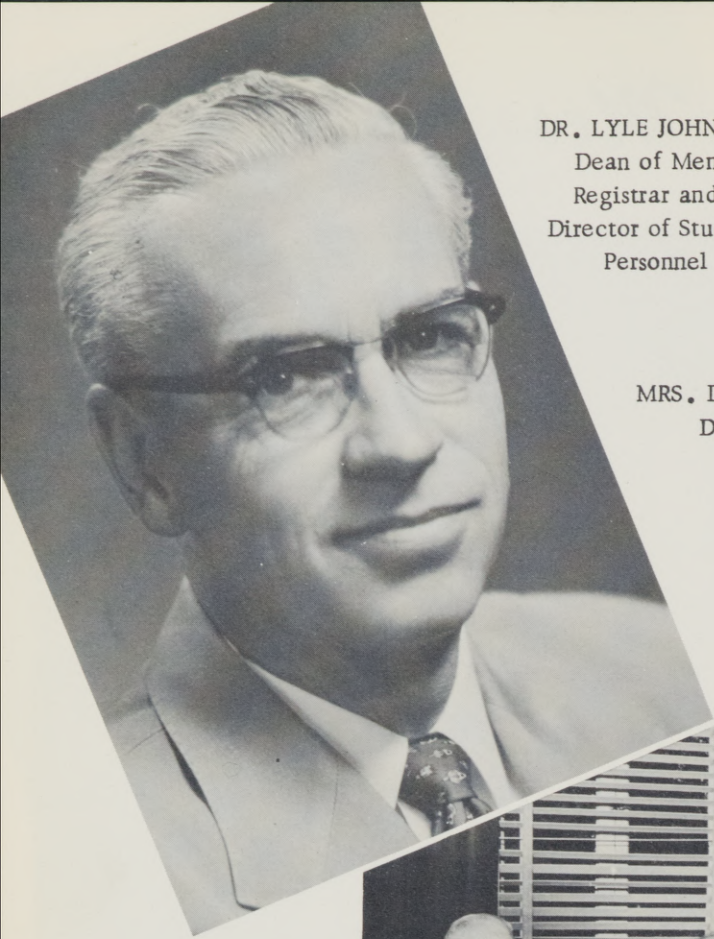
Three new staff members have been added this year. During the past year two additional staff members received their doctoral degrees. This makes a total of five staff members to complete their degree work since 1954.

We are grateful for all this and especially for continued support of our State Board, the Chancellor's Office and a host of loyal supporters.





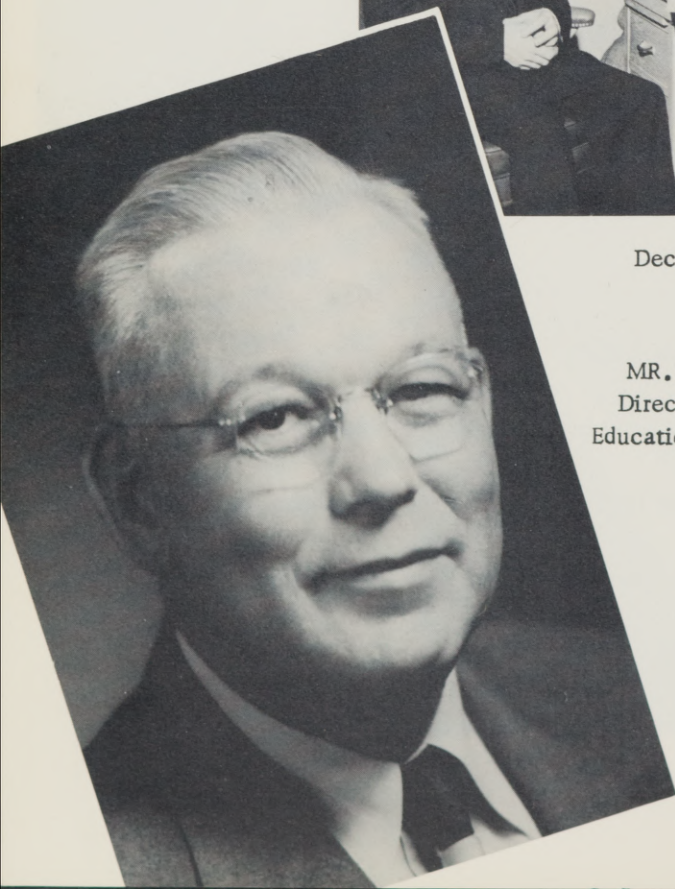

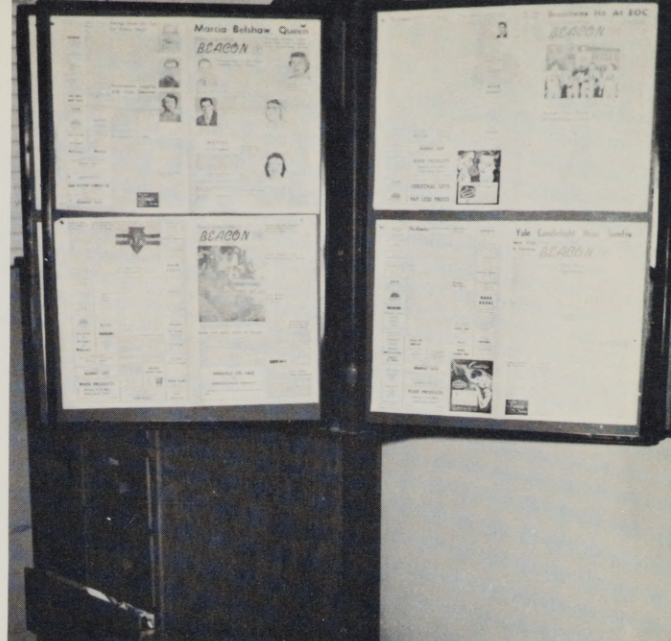


Iota Phi Omicron
