We wanted to provide a resource for you to teach your preschooler about Jesus and how He wants to be their friend forever! Check out the page below for this fun activity!

It's our hope and prayer that this craft helps your child see how much Jesus loves all of us!



Here are the supplies you need: construction paper, washable paint, a paper plate, and hand wipes.

You're going to be making a handprint cross!

Lay out the construction paper. Put some washable paint on the paper plate.

Then, dip your child's hand in the paint. Then, help them put 3 handprints vertically on the construction paper. Next, help them put 2 horizontally on the sides (making the shape of the cross.) When finished, use the hand wipes to wipe off the paint from your child's hands.

Throughout the activity, talk to your child about how Jesus wants to be their friend forever! Tell them that even our handprints remind us how God made us all special and unique!

Explain that one very sad day, Jesus died. Then, get really excited and tell them that Jesus rose from the dead! He is alive! And He wants to be a friend to all of us forever!

That's it! Now, you have a special craft to remind your family of Jesus and His love!
