

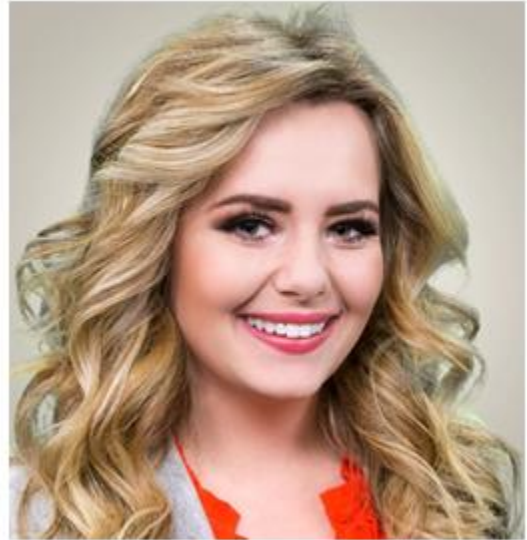
Jessica Coombs
