

GUIDELINES *for* HAPPY CAMPING

REGISTRATION: All camping fees must be paid for in advance.

CHECK-OUT TIME: Please check-out or re-register by noon.

Thereafter there will be a \$10 per hour charge up to 4 PM.

After 4 PM you will be charged for another night.

PLEASE DO NOT CHANGE your assigned site before checking with the office.

GUESTS of campers must register at the office upon arrival.

SMOKERS please use ash trays.

PLEASE PLACE TRASH in plastic bags and put in dumpsters provided by the campground. They are indicated on the Park Map.

FIREARMS/FIREWORKS shall not be discharged within the campground.

QUIET HOURS are 10 PM to 7 AM.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE 5 MPH SPEED LIMIT.

PETS must be kept on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet and deposit waste in trash cans. Pets may not be left unattended outside at any time. Do not leave pets in a hot RV or tent. Please do not allow your pet to disturb other guests. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated.
