## 10-12 Months To Go


- Set your budget and outline your top priorities. Decide where to save and where to splurge.
- Start gathering inspiration—scroll social media, browse magazines, and create a vision for your wedding style and color palette.
- Draft your preliminary guest list (you'll need a headcount for venues and vendors).
- Choose your wedding party. Ask early so they have time to plan and prepare.
- Secure your ceremony and/or reception venue and lock in your wedding date.
- Consider wedding insurance. Ask your venue about liability coverage and explore options like cancellation insurance.
- Send save-the-dates: 8–12 months in advance for destination weddings, 6–9 months for local celebrations.
- Create a wedding website and include the URL on your save-the-date cards.
- Begin dress or suit shopping and start pulling together accessories. Trunk shows and expos can be great for ideas.
- Consider hiring a wedding planner—especially if the process already feels overwhelming.
- Begin assembling your vendor team: caterer, photographer, videographer, officiant, etc. Always get contracts in writing.
- Start dreaming up your honeymoon—it's a great way to take a break from planning stress.



## 6-9 Months To Go

- Hire a floral designer and explore arrangement styles that fit your vision and budget.
- Book your wedding cake tasting and finalize the design with your baker.
- Hire your DJ or live entertainment. Work together on playlists for each part of the day.
- Order your invitations. Discuss paper type, design, and wording with a stationer or digital vendor.
- Create your gift registry—and update your website with the links.
- Arrange hotel room blocks for guests and book your own suite.
- Shop for bridesmaid dresses, flower girl outfits, or groomsmen attire. Give clear ordering instructions.
- Arrange and book transportation for the wedding day.
- Go over bridal shower and/or bachelor/bachelorette party details with the host(s).
- Consider premarital counseling. A strong foundation helps keep things grounded and meaningful.







## 3-5 Months To Go


- Reserve your rehearsal and rehearsal dinner venue. Lock in any extra décor or entertainment.
- Finalize your rehearsal dinner guest list (typically immediate family, wedding party + guests, officiant, etc.).
- Make childcare arrangements and/or entertainment plans for young guests.
- Reserve all necessary party rentals and linens.
- Order guest favors—or choose a charitable donation in their honor.
- Finalize your guest list and organize mailing addresses into a spreadsheet.
- Confirm invitation wording and schedule pickup/delivery for all printed materials.
- Select your ceremony readings and write or finalize your vows.
- Finalize your menu, beverage selections, and catering details.
- Work with your planner and venue on the wedding day timeline and reception formalities.
- Schedule a hair and makeup trial, and book your beauty team. Begin a self-care or fitness routine if desired.
- Shop for wedding rings and order engraving, if applicable.
- Finalize your honeymoon or weddingmoon plans and confirm travel documents (double-check passports!).



## ó-8 Weeks To Go

- Send out invitations. Have a system ready to track RSVPs and meal choices.
- Discuss contingency plans with your venue if you're hosting anything outdoors.
- Confirm date, details, and deposits with all vendors.
- Research marriage license requirements and name change steps, if applicable.
- Begin attire fittings. Don't forget the right undergarments.
- Check in with your wedding party on outfit orders and deadlines.
- Send thank-you notes for any early gifts or shower presents.
- Start assembling guest welcome bags, if applicable.







## 3-5 Weeks To Go

- Send rehearsal dinner invitations (e-vites work for casual gatherings).
- Finalize and confirm:
  - Wedding vows and ceremony readings with your officiant
  - Shot list with your photographer/videographer
  - Music selections for the ceremony, cocktail hour, and reception
  - Reception timeline and toasts
  - Wedding night and honeymoon accommodations
- Obtain your marriage license and complete name-change documents if needed.
- Pick up your wedding rings and double-check any engraving.
- If you're sentimental, gather your "something old, new, borrowed, and blue."
- Purchase day-of accessories: guest book, toasting flutes, cake server, unity candles, ring pillow, etc.
- Buy gifts (optional) for your partner, wedding party, or parents.
- Have your final attire fitting—bring your shoes and accessories.
- Follow up with any guests who haven't RSVP'd.



## 1-2 Weeks To Go

- Provide your final guest count to the caterer or venue.
- Finalize seating arrangements and create your seating chart or place cards.
- Pick up your wedding dress or suit.
- Confirm arrival times and final timeline with vendors and your wedding party. Share a copy with your maid of honor or point person.
- Go over logistics and pickup details with your transportation vendor.
- Drop off wedding favors, décor, and any printed materials to your venue or planner, along with setup instructions.
- Pack a wedding day emergency kit: sewing kit, meds, tape, stain remover, extra contacts, etc.
- Check the weather. Revisit backup plans if needed.
- Start packing for your honeymoon.
- Need a facial or massage? Now's the time.








## The Final Days


- Pack all wedding-day items in one place—don't forget the rings or your marriage license.




