Otyokwa is a restored 1930's boys camp on Lake Pemaquid in Bremen, ME, set on 40 acres of rolling meadows and 2,000 ft of lakeside shore.

Featuring a 4-season Farmhouse, 5 lakeside cottages, a Rec Hall, Kitchen Cabin and sauna — an exclusive Maine event venue specializing in intimate gatherings and small ceremonies, naturally integrated into the landscape.

HISTORY

As a thriving boys camp from 1935 to 1941, Camp Otyokwa provided city kids a crash course in outdoor skills, physical labor and play, and self-reliance — in what was, at the time, the 'Far North' of Maine.

The extensive photos and writings from the time show 75 boys spending their days swimming, hiking, playing games, and establishing trail networks — some of which still exist on the property today.


From a 1930's boys camp to today's intimate event venue — the spirit of gathering by the lake remains.
