Seminary Hill is an all-season flexible space that offers a distinctive venue to host your weekend wedding. Located 2 ½ hours northwest of New York City, our holistic apple and pear orchard and working cidery provide breathtaking views of the Catskills and the Delaware River Valley. We offer both indoor and outdoor settings. You may stage your ceremony on a high ridge overlooking the Delaware River or nestled among the apple and pear trees. You may serve lunch or dinner in our award-winning Tasting Room or our elegant Wedding Tent. Our Executive Chef Jack Tippett has created seasonal catering menus that pair perfectly with our ciders.

Included in the wedding package is the Mountain House and Cottage, sleeping ten guests. Additional lodging for 40 guests is available at the Boarding House and House on Upper Main in Callicoon, the small town just down the hill that is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Seminary Hill's warm professionalism makes this the ideal setting for your wedding!

# A NOTE FROM THE OWNERS




"Reinventing Tradition"

# ORCHARD



Our 1,500-tree orchard overlooks a former seminary nestled at the bottom of the hill. In spring, the trees blossom in varied hues of white and pink. In summer, our 60+ varieties of apples and pears ripen on the branches. In fall, vibrant foliage provides a gorgeous backdrop to harvest time.

# CIDERY & TASTING ROOM



Overlooking the orchard, the cidery combines a ground-floor production facility with a top -floor tasting room and event space. The wood inside and outside the cidery is larch reclaimed from the underwater pilings of the old Tappan Zee Bridge.

Distinctively shaped table tops throughout the tasting room are made from oak cleared from the land while building the cidery. Nestled next to the Tasting Room is our 250 person event tent. Whether you stage your event indoors or outdoors, you will have spectacular views of the Delaware River Valley. We can organize special tours of the orchard and cidery for your guests, or you can present your guests with bottles of ciders as mementos of your event.


# MOUNTAIN HOUSE & COTTAGE



Just around the corner from the Orchard and Cidery sit the Mountain House and Cottage (5 bedrooms and 3 bathrooms) with stunning views in all directions. Built from timber felled on the property, the houses are simply furnished, with kilim rugs covering the wood floors, a vaulted living room with a fireplace, fully equipped kitchen, washer and dryer, and an herb and vegetable garden. Sitting atop a ridge, the Mountain House & Cottage encompass 65 acres of private land. The winding Delaware River and the rolling hills of the Catskills converge to form breathtaking scenes for photographs and vows. The stone fire pit is the perfect place to watch the sunset.

# **QUESTIONS**

# what is the timing for my wedding?

Amplified music must be turned off by 10pm. Wedding must end by midnight.

### do you have any guidelines concering departures?

We love seeing final departure photos. However, to ensure the safety of your guests and our environment we do not allow fireworks of any kind, sparklers, confetti, glitter, streamers, sky/wish lanterns.

# do you allow pets on property?

Yes. All guests bringing pets must sign the Seminary Hill Pet Agreement, affirming that they agree to all pet policies and are personally responsible for their pet, including any liability arising from their pets' actions. Please note Seminary Hill has the right to refuse any pet at its discretion for any reason excluding certified service dogs/pets. Only certified service dogs are allowed in our Tasting Room.

# do i need event / vendor insurance?

Seminary Hill will provide event insurance. However, your vendors will need to provide proof of their own liability policies.

#### do you allow decorations?

Yes. We welcome decorations. Speak to your wedding and event coordinator for more details.

# can we bring our own aclohol?

No, you can choose from our bar services or inquire with your licensed caterer for purchasing and serving alcohol.

# can our caterer use the tasting room kitchen?

Please speak to your wedding coordinator. if your caterer will need to use the kitchen, we require an additional \$500 security deposit for kitchen use.

# will the tasting room be open to the public on the day of our wedding?

The tasting room business will remain open to the public, but will be relocated to our lower barn as to not interfere with your wedding. If you wish to have the lower barn closed, you must pay an additional \$5,000. Please note the maximum capacity of the tasting room is 100 guests for the tasting room and it closes at midnight during weddings.

# **QUESTIONS**

# how much time is allowed for set up / clean up?

You can begin setting up as early as 9am on the day of your event, unless other arrangements are agreed upon prior to the event.

All items must be removed / picked up by 10am the day after your event, unless other arrangements are agreed upon prior to the event. A fee will be applied if this rule is not followed.

# what is the timing for a ceremony rehearsal?

A ceremony rehearsal can be hosted prior to your wedding. All rehearsals must be completed by 5:00pm.

# what is the payment schedule?

You will have 10 days from the date the contract is issued to sign and return the agreement along with the refundable security deposit \$500 and initial 25% deposit. The remaining balance is due 6 months prior to the event.

# what is the security deposit?

This is to cover potential damage by your guests and will be refundable in ten (10) business days following the event. If any damages have occurred, you will be notified and we will bill you for any repairs over and above the deposit.
